The new division boundaries for the communities of Coalville, Whitwick, Hugglescote and Ellistown are much better than the previous suggestion. I am glad that historical and cultural concerns have been taken into account. The Whitwick division is now self-contained and does not transgress the sensitive 'Green Wedge' . The Division boundaries respect the history of this ancient settlement. The new Coalville South Division re-joins the community of Hugglescote with Ellistown, which is in the same Ecclesiastical Parish. This makes sense as much community action takes place in the Churches. Coalville South also reaches across the proposed SE Coalville development area and the A511 to Greenhill and Agar Nook. This again makes sense as the two communities share an interest in the A511 and the effect of housing and growth on transport infrastructure. Keeping Coalville town centre as one Division also makes cultural and historic sense and it is good to see this Victorian new-town retaining its special identity. As far as my town and its satellite villages go, I am pleased with the work done by the Boundary Commission and fully support the changes. The only glitch I have spotted is where Glebe View appears to be cut off from Claremont Drive in the north-west corner of Coalville North.
