## **Part A**

Changes effected by Order of the Secretary of State

1. Changes effected by Order of the Secretary of State under section 86 (A1), (4) (7), 87 (1), (3) and 105 of the Local Government Act 2000.

There are three Orders made by the Secretary of State, which made changes to the scheme of elections.

### **The Borough of Rotherham (Scheme of Elections) Order 2015**

This Order provides a new scheme for the holding of the ordinary elections of councillors of all wards within the borough of Rotherham. It replaces the previous scheme for the ordinary election of councillors by thirds. It also changes the year of election for parish councillors for all parishes within the borough.

### **The City of Birmingham (Scheme of Elections) Order 2015**

This Order provides a new scheme for the holding of the ordinary elections of councillors of all wards in the City of Birmingham. It replaces the previous scheme for the ordinary election of councillors by thirds. It also changes the year of election for parish councillors in the parish of New Frankley within the city.

### **The City of Birmingham (Scheme of Elections) (Amendment) Order 2015**

The City of Birmingham (Scheme of Elections) Order 2015 (S.I.2015/43) provides a new scheme for the holding of the ordinary elections of councillors of all wards in the City of Birmingham from 2017. It also provides for the parish of New Frankley to have parish council elections in 2017. This Order amends the City of Birmingham (Scheme of Elections) Order 2015 so that the first elections will take place in 2018.

2. Changes effected by Order of the Secretary of State under section 1 of the Legislative and Regulatory Reform Act 2006 (a)

There is one Order made by the Secretary of State, which has made changes to the community governance review legislation.

### **The Legislative Reform (Community Governance Reviews) Order 2015**

The Order is made under the provisions of the Legislative and Regulatory Reform Act 2006 (c.51) and amends the Local Government and Public Involvement in Health Act 2007 ("the 2007 Act") to remove burdens on those who wish to campaign to set up a new parish council.

3. Changes effected by Order made by the Secretary of State under part 6 of the Local Democracy, Economic Development and Construction Act 2009

There is one Order made by the Secretary of State, which provided for the establishment of combined authorities for the areas of two or more local authorities in England.

## **The Greater Manchester Combined Authority (Amendment) Order 2015 No. 960**

This order amends the Greater Manchester Combined Authority Order (S.I. 2011/908).

Part 6 of the Local Democracy, Economic Development and Construction Act 2009 (“the 2009 Act”) provides for the establishment of combined authorities for the areas of two or more local authorities in England. Combined authorities are bodies corporate which may be given power to exercise functions relating to transport and to economic development and regeneration in their area.

The Secretary of State may only make changes to existing combined authority arrangements for an area where a scheme for such an authority has been published under section 112 of the 2009 Act. This Order has been made following the publication of such a scheme on 19th December 2014 by the constituent councils whose areas together make up the Greater Manchester Combined Authority. ## **Part B**

Changes effected by local authorities' action or Order as notified to the Secretary of State and the Local Government Boundary Commission for England

1. There are one hundred and four Orders, made by local authorities, which give effect to amending electoral arrangements under the Local Government and Public Involvement in Health Act 2007

### **The Swale Borough Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance) Order 2015**

This Order gives effect to recommendations made by Swale Borough Council for the alteration of the area of the parishes of Bobbing, Borden and Tunstall and for the increase in the number of Parish Councillors for the parish of Iwade within the borough of Swale.

The parishes of Bobbing, Borden and Tunstall will be altered with effect from 1 April 2015. The electoral arrangements apply in respect of parish elections to be held on and after the ordinary day of election of councillors in 2015.

### **The Warwick District Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance Order 2015)**

This Order gives effect to recommendations made by Warwick District Council for the alteration of the areas of the parish councils for Ashow and Stoneleigh, Barford, Sherbourne and Wasperton, Bishop's Tachbrook, Budbrooke, Burton Green, Kenilworth, Leek Wootton and Guys Cliffe, Old Milverton and Blackdown, Royal Leamington Spa, Warwick and Whitnash within the district of Warwick. The electoral arrangements apply in respect of parish elections to be held on and after the ordinary day of election of councillors on Thursday 7 May, 2015.

### **The Wycombe District Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance) Order 2015 (“the Order”)**

This Order gives effect to recommendations made by Wycombe District Council for the alteration of the area of the parish of Lacey Green and the parish of Hughenden and comes into force the day after it is made. The number of parish councillors are unaffected.

### **The Kettering Borough Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance) Order 2015**

This Order gives effect to recommendations made by Kettering Borough Council for the alteration of the area of the parish of Mawsley and the parish of Cransley, the alteration of the area of the parish of Rushton and the parish of Wilbarston, the alteration of number of parish councillors for the parish of Rushton and the parish of Wilbarston and the abolition of the parish wards for the parish of Barton Seagrove and the parish of Burton Latimer. The Order shall come into force on the day after it was made – 3<sup>rd</sup> February 2015.

### **The Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance) (Macclesfield) Order 2015**

This Order gives effect to a decision made by Cheshire East Borough Council for the creation of a new parish and a parish council for Macclesfield within the borough of Cheshire East. The new parish will be created with effect from 1 April 2015. The electoral arrangements for the parish council apply in respect of parish elections to be held on 7 May 2015.

### **The Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance) (Acton Town) Order 2015**

This Order gives effect to recommendations made by Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council in the community governance review for the parish of Acton Bridge. The parish of Acton Bridge will be altered with effect from 1<sup>st</sup> April 2015.

### **The Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance) (Aldersey, Barton, Carden, Clutton, Coddington and Stretton) Order 2015**

This Order gives effect to recommendations made by Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council in the community governance review for the parishes of Aldersey, Barton, Carden, Clutton, Coddington and Stretton. The parishes of Clutton and Carden will be altered with effect from 1<sup>st</sup> April 2015.

### **The Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance) (Aldford, Buerton, Churton Heath, Lea Newbold and Saughton) Order 2015**

This Order gives effect to recommendations made by Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council in the community governance review for the parishes of Aldford, Buerton, Churton Heath, Lea Newbold and Saughton. It provides for the alteration of parish boundaries, the amalgamation of the existing parishes of Aldford, Buerton, Churton Heath, Lea Newbold and Saughton to constitute the new parish of Aldford and Saughton and the creation of a parish council for the new parish within the borough.

The new parish of Aldford and Saughton will be created from the 1<sup>st</sup> April 2015. The electoral arrangements apply in respect of parish elections to be held on and after the ordinary day of election of councillors in 2015.

### **The Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance) (Anderton with Marbury) Order 2015**

This Order gives effect to recommendations made by Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council in the community governance review for the parish of Anderton with Marbury. The parish of Anderton with Marbury will be altered from 1<sup>st</sup> April 2015.

### **The Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance) (Ashton Hayes and Horton-cum-Peel) Order 2015**

This Order gives effect to recommendations made by Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council in the community governance review for the parishes of Ashton Hayes and Horton-cum-Peel. It provides for the alteration of parish boundaries, the amalgamation of the existing parishes of Ashton Hayes and Horton-cum-Peel to constitute the new parish of Ashton Hayes and Horton-cum-Peel and the creation of a parish council for the new parish within the borough.

The new parish of Ashton Hayes and Horton-cum-Peel will be created with effect from 1<sup>st</sup> April 2015. The electoral arrangements apply in respect of parish elections to be held on and after the ordinary day of election of councillors in 2015.

#### **The Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance) (Aston) Order 2015**

This Order gives effect to recommendations made by Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council in the community governance review for the parish of Aston. The parish of Aston will be altered with effect from 1<sup>st</sup> April 2015.

#### **The Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance) (Backford, Caughall, Chorlton-by-Backford) Order 2015**

This Order gives effect to recommendations made by Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council in the community governance review for the parishes of Backford, Caughall and Chorlton-by-Backford. It provides for the amalgamation of the existing parishes of Backford, Caughall and Chorlton-by-Backford to constitute the new parish of Backford and the creation of a parish council for the new parish within the borough.

The new parish of Backford will be created from 1<sup>st</sup> April 2015. The electoral arrangements apply in respect of parish elections to be held on and after the ordinary day of election of councillors in 2015.

#### **The Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance) (Barnton) Order 2015**

This Order gives effect to recommendations made by Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council in the community governance review for the parish of Barnton. The parish of Barnton will be altered with effect from 1<sup>st</sup> April 2015.

#### **The Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance) (Bickley, Edge, Hampton, Larkton) Order 2015**

This Order gives effect to recommendations made by Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council in the community governance review for the parishes of Bickley, Edge, Hampton and Larkton. It provides for the alteration of parish boundaries, the amalgamation of the existing parishes of Bickley, Edge, Hampton and Larkton to constitute the new parish of No Man's Heath and District and the creation of a parish council for the new parish within the borough.

The new parish of No Man's Heath and District will be created with effect from 1<sup>st</sup> April 2015. The electoral arrangements apply in respect of parish elections to be held on and after the ordinary day of election of councillors in 2015.

**The Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance) (Bradley, Macefen, Tushingham-cum-Grindley) Order 2015**

This Order gives effect to recommendations made by Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council in the community governance review for the parishes of Bradley, Macefen and Tushingham-cum-Grindley. It provides for the alteration of parish boundaries and the amalgamation of the existing parishes to constitute the new parish of Tushingham-cum-Grindley, Macefen and Bradley. The new parish of Tushingham-cum-Grindley, Macefen and Bradley will be created with effect from 1<sup>st</sup> April 2015.

**The Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance) (Bridge Trafford, Hoole Village, Mickle Trafford, Picton, Wimbolds Trafford) Order 2015**

This Order gives effect to recommendations made by Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council in the community governance review for the parishes of Bridge Trafford, Hoole Village, Mickle Trafford, Picton and Wimbolds Trafford. It provides for the alteration of parish boundaries, the amalgamation of the existing parishes of Bridge Trafford, Hoole Village, Mickle Trafford, Picton and Wimbolds Trafford to constitute the new parish of Mickle Trafford and District and the creation of a parish council for the new parish for the borough. The new parish of Mickle Trafford and District will be created with effect from 1<sup>st</sup> April 2015. The electoral arrangements apply in respect of parish elections to be held on and after the ordinary day of election of councillors in 2015.

**The Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance) (Bruen Stapleford, Hockenhull, Priors Heys, and Tarvin) Order 2015**

This Order gives effect to recommendations made by Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council in the community governance review for the parishes of Bruen Stapleford, Hockenhull, Priors Heys and Tarvin. It provides for the alteration of parish boundaries, the amalgamation of the existing parishes of Bruen Stapleford, Hockenhull, Priors Heys and Tarvin to constitute the new parish of Tarvin and the creation of a parish council for the new parish within the borough. The new parish of Tarvin will be created with effect from 1<sup>st</sup> April 2015. The electoral arrangements apply in respect of parish elections to be held on and after the ordinary day of election of councillors in 2015.

**The Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance) (Burton and Duddon) Order 2015**

This Order gives effect to recommendations made by Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council in the community governance review for the parishes of Burton and Duddon. It provides for the alteration of parish boundaries, the amalgamation of the existing parishes of Burton and Duddon to constitute the new parish of Duddon and the creation of a parish council for the new parish within the borough.

The new parish of Duddon will be created with effect from 1<sup>st</sup> April 2015. The electoral arrangements apply in respect of parish elections to be held on and after the ordinary day of election of councillors in 2015.

#### **The Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance) (Burwardsley) Order 2015**

This Order gives effect to recommendations made by Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council in the community governance review for the parish of Burwardsley. The electoral arrangements apply in respect of parish elections to be held on and after the ordinary day of election of councillors in 2015.

#### **The Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance) (Caldecott, Church Shocklach, Horton-by-Malpas, Shocklach Oviatt) Order 2015**

This Order gives effect to recommendations made by Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council in the community governance review for the parishes of Caldecott, Church Shocklach, Horton-by-Malpas and Shocklach Oviatt. It provides for the amalgamation of the existing parishes of Caldecott, Church Shocklach, Horton-by-Malpas and Shocklach Oviatt to constitute the new parish of Shocklach Oviatt and District and the creation of a parish council for the new parish within the borough.

The new parish of Shocklach Oviatt and District will be created with effect from 1<sup>st</sup> April 2015. The electoral arrangements apply in respect of parish elections to be held on and after the ordinary day of election of councillors in 2015.

#### **The Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance) (Capenhurst and Ledsham) Order 2015**

This Order gives effect to recommendations made by Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council in the community governance review for the parishes of Capenhurst and Ledsham. The boundary of the parish of Ledsham will be altered with effect from 1<sup>st</sup> April 2015.

#### **The Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance) (Chowley, Golborne David, Handley) Order 2015**

This Order gives effect to recommendations made by Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council in the community governance review for the parishes of Chowley, Golborne David and Handley. The boundary of the parish of Golborne David will be altered with effect from 1<sup>st</sup> April 2015.



### **The Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance) (Christleton and Cotton Edmunds) Order 2015**

### **The Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance) (Churton-by-Aldford, Churton-by-Farndon, Edgerley) Order 2015**

This Order gives effect to recommendations made by Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council in the community governance review for the parishes of Churton-by-Aldford, Churton-by-Farndon and Edgerley. It provides for the amalgamation of the existing parishes of Churton-by-Aldford, Churton-by-Farndon and Edgerley to constitute the new parish of Churton and the creation of a parish council for the new parish within the borough.

### **The Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance) (Clotton Hoofield, and Iddinshall) Order 2015**

This Order gives effect to recommendations made by Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council in the community governance review for the parishes of Clotton Hoofield and Iddinshall. ### **The Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance) (Cotton Abbots and Waverton) Order 2015**

This Order gives effect to recommendations made by Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council in the community governance review for the parishes of Cotton Abbots and Waverton. It provides for the alteration of parish boundaries, the amalgamation of the existing parishes of Cotton Abbots and Waverton to constitute the new parish of Waverton and the creation of a parish council for the new parish within the borough.

The new parish of Waverton will be created with effect from 1<sup>st</sup> April 2015. The electoral arrangements apply in respect of parish elections to be held on and after the ordinary day of election of councillors in 2015.

**The Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance) (Crewe-by-Farndon, Farndon and Kings Marsh) Order 2015**

This Order gives effect to recommendations made by Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council in the community governance review for the parishes of Crewe-by-Farndon, Farndon and Kings Marsh. **The Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance) (Croughton, Little Stanney, Stoke, Wervin) Order 2015**

This Order gives effect to recommendations made by Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council in the community governance review for the parishes of Croughton, Little Stanney, Stoke and Wervin. The order changes the name of the parish of Stoke to Stoak. The Order also specifies the number of parish councillors each parish council should have.

**The Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance) (Crowton) Order 2015**

This Order gives effect to recommendations made by Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council in the community governance review for the parish of Crowton. The parish of Crowton will be altered with effect from 1<sup>st</sup> April 2015.

**The Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance) (Cuddington) Order 2015**

This Order gives effect to recommendations made by Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council in the community governance review for the parish of Cuddington. **The Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance) (Doddleston, Lower Kinnerton, Marlston-cum-Lache) Order 2015**

This Order gives effect to recommendations made by Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council in the community governance review for the parishes of Doddleston, Lower Kinnerton and Marlston-cum-Lache. It provides for the alteration of parish boundaries, the amalgamation of the existing parishes of Doddleston, Lower Kinnerton and Marlston-cum-Lache to constitute the new parish of Doddleston and the creation of a parish council for the new parish within the borough.

The new parish of Doddleston will be created with effect from 1<sup>st</sup> April 2015. The electoral arrangements apply in respect of parish elections to be held on and after the ordinary day election of councillors in 2015.

**The Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance) (Dunham-on-the-Hill and Hapsford) Order 2015**

**The Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance) (Dutton) Order 2015**

This Order gives effect to recommendations made by Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council in the community governance review of Dutton. The parish will be altered with effect from 1<sup>st</sup> April 2015.

**The Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance) (Eaton, Eccleston, Claverton) Order 2015**

**The Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance) (Frodsham) Order 2015**

This Order gives effect to recommendations made by Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council in the community governance review for the parish of Frodsham. The parish of Frodsham will be altered with effect from 1<sup>st</sup> April 2015. The electoral arrangements apply in respect of parish elections to be held on and after the ordinary day of election of councillors in 2015.

**The Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance) (Golborne Bellow, Newton-by-Tattenhall, Tattenhall) Order 2015**

The new parish of Tattenhall and District will be created with effect from 1<sup>st</sup> April 2015. The electoral arrangements apply in respect of parish elections to be held on and after the ordinary day of election of councillors in 2015.

#### **The Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance) (Grafton and Tilston) Order 2015**

This Order gives effect to recommendations made by Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council in the community governance review for the parishes of Tilston and Grafton. ### **The South Oxfordshire (Reorganisation of Community Governance) Order 2015**

This Order gives effect to recommendations made by South Oxfordshire Order 2015. The Order dissolves the parish councils for the parishes of Aston Tirrold and Aston Upthorpe and groups those parishes under a common parish council. The Order alters the area of the parishes of Brightwell-cum-Sotwell, Cholsey, Clifton Hampden, Culham, Didcot, East Hagbourne, Eye and Dunsden, Goring Heath, Great Milton, Harpsden, Henley-on-Thames, Holton, Kidmore End, Long Wittenham, Marsh Baldon, North Moreton, Nuneham Courtenay, Pishall with Stonor, Pyrton, Shiplake, Sonning Common, South Moreton, Tiddington with Albury, Wallingford, Waterstock, Watlington, West Hagbourne, Wheatley and Woodcote. The Order abolishes the wards of the parishes of Cholsey and East Hagbourne and specifies the number of parish councillors for each parish. Finally the Order changes the name of the parish of Goring to Goring-on-Thames. This Order was made 18 February 2015.

### **Vale of White Horse District Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance) Order 2015**

This Order gives effect to recommendations made by Vale of White Horse District Council on 16 July 2014. The Order specifies the number of parish councillors for the parishes of Chilton, Hinton Waldrist and Letcombe Regis. The Order alters the area of the parishes of Appleton with Eaton, Besselseleigh, Cumnor, Fyfield and Tubney, Harwell, Kennington, Kingston Bagpuize with Southmoor, Longcot, Marcham, Milton, Radley, St Helen Without, Sutton Courtney and Watchfield. The Order renames two wards and specifies the number of parish councillors for

all wards of the parish of Abingdon-on-Thames. The Order divides the parish of Cumnor into four wards and specifies the names and the number of parish councillors for each of those wards. This Order was made 17 February 2015.

### **Durham County Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance) Order 2015**

This Order gives effect to recommendations made by Durham County Council on 23 September 2015. The Order specifies that the unparished area of Newfield is to become part of the parish of Pelton.

### **The District of Thanet (Reorganisation of Community Governance) Order 2015**

This Order gives effect to a decision made by Thanet District Council for the new parish of Westgate, and a creation of a council for the parish of Westgate within the district of Thanet.

The parish of Westgate will be created with effect from 1 April 2015. The electoral arrangements apply in respect of parish elections to be held on and after the ordinary day of election of councillors in 2015.

### **The Maidstone (Reorganisation of Community Governance) Order 2015**

The Order increased the number of councillors in Harrietsham Parish Council by two – from nine to eleven councillors. The Order came into effect on 1 April 2015.

### **The Stratford-on-Avon (Reorganisation of Community Governance) Order 2015**

The Order specified the number of councillors to be elected to Snitterfield Parish Council should be eight. The Order came into effect on 1 April 2015.

The parish of Pannal and Burn Bridge will be created with effect from 1 April 2016. The electoral arrangements apply in respect of parish elections to be held on and after the ordinary day of election of councillors in 2016.

### **The Shropshire Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance) Order 2015**

The order changes the name of the parish of Myddle and Broughton to Myddle, Broughton and Harmer Hill. The Order will come into effect on 1 January 2016.

### **The Rutland County Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance) Order 2015**

This Order gives effect to recommendations made by Rutland County Council to amalgamate the Exton parish and Horn parish and create a new parish of Exton and Horn. The existing parishes will cease to exist. The number of parish councillors for the new parish shall be nine. The Order will come into effect on 1 April 2016.

## **Part E** **Consent Cases**

### **Selby**

Selby District Council undertook a community governance review in 2014 which proposed to amend the parish warding arrangements in Wistow parish and Selby town. Electoral arrangements for Wistow parish and Selby town were provided for in the Selby (Electoral Changes) Order 2014. As such, these are protected electoral arrangements under the Local Government and Public Involvement in Health Act 2007. The Commission has granted its consent for the proposed changes. The Commission also grants its consent to change the parish electoral arrangements in the manner set out in the Council's request of 18th February. This allows the Council to make an Order altering the electoral arrangements in Wistow parish and Selby town, as provided for in section 86 of the Act.

### **Middlesbrough**

Middlesbrough Borough Council requested consent to change the name of Kader ward to Kader & Brookfield ward. Consent was refused on 14 September 2015. During its electoral review of Middlesbrough the Commission held three stages of public consultation and as a result of those consultations, the Commission considered that the name Kader was most appropriate for the new ward. Whilst the Commission acknowledges that there is some local support for re-naming the ward, there is also some opposition to changing the name. In light of this opposition and in addition to the evidence gathered during the review, the Commission considers that the name Kader should be retained.

### **Bromsgrove**

Bromsgrove District Council undertook a community governance review in 2015 which proposed to move an area of the parish of Clent to the parish of Hagley. Consent was required as the electoral arrangements for Clent and Hagley were protected for five years since the Bromsgrove (Electoral Changes) Order 2014 was made. Consent for the transfer has been given.

### **North Somerset**

On 6 August 2015 North Somerset wrote to the Commission requesting consent to change the protected electoral ward name of Weston-super-Mare Bournville. This is provided for in the North Somerset (Electoral Changes) Order 2014. The Commission granted consent for the Council to change the electoral ward name of Weston-super-Mare Bournville to Weston-super-Mare South.

### **Darlington**

Darlington Borough Council undertook a community governance review in 2015 which proposed to change the parish boundary of Hurworth parish which would result in changes to Hurworth's parish wards and to abolish the parish of Low Dinsdale. The electoral arrangements for Hurworth and Low Dinsdale were protected for five years from 16 December 2014 when the Darlington (Electoral Changes) Order 2014 was made. Consent was therefore needed for the reorganisation of



community governance order to be made and consent was granted on 7 December 2015.
