Dear Sir or Madam,

Warnham Parish Council wishes to object to the proposed changes to the division boundaries in West Sussex.

The proposals include grouping Warnham Parish into the new Broadbridge ward. Although the Parish Council can understand the rationalisation of grouping parishes to be represented by a single WSCC councillor, the council is of the opinion that being grouped with Broadbridge Heath is inappropriate. Broadbridge Heath is nearly 100% developed as a suburb of Horsham compared to Warnham which is a rural parish. The Parish Council want to ensure that Warnham's rural identity is maintained and that rural issues are a priority for its County Councillor.

If the parish is grouped with Broadbridge Heath and its new developments, the new ward will not easily be able to reflect the interests and identities of local communities as they will be so diverse.
