With reference to the proposed new Trinity ward boundary encompassing part of Sandyhurst Lane, Lenacre Street , Sandyacres & Lenacre Hall Farm. We are strongly against this proposal for the following reasons: Having been born in Ashford we always remember Sandyhurst Lane as a special community whilst growing up, then becoming residents in 1991 we then experienced first hand the community spirit amongst the residents of the Lane, watching out for each other through the Residents Association and the Neighbourhood Watch scheme. The community come together utilising our social club site 'Sandyacres' and the local historic Public Houses 'The Hare & Hounds' & the 'Flying Horse'. We border the Eastwell Park Estate and it is ironic that the front cover of the Boughton Aluph & Eastwell Parish Design Statement shows an image of Eastwell Towers which are to be within the new 'Trinity Ward'. We strongly believe that the proposed new boundaries will split the existing community by inserting urban and commercial sites within its existing rural boundaries. We believe the tree line behind the houses on the even side Sandyhurst Lane forms a natural boundary between the Trinity Road Estate and the historic rural community beyond This should be where the new boundary is located.
