Submission by Hartley & District Residents' Association to the proposed Boundary changes in the Purley, Coulsdon and Kenley areas.

Our Residents' Association, HADRA, straddles both Coulsdon and Purley and under the new proposals will come under four different wards. We understand and agree with the principles of the new boundaries but would like to make the following couple of points about roads in our area:

Proposed changes

1. **Stoats Nest Road** move the section between The Brighton Road and the Railway Bridge from Purley into Coulsdon Town.
Reason: It is in the postal district of Coulsdon and has a CR5 post code. The residents believe they live in Coulsdon not Kenley or Purley. This would mean all Stoats Nest Road would be in the same ward.
This affects 15 properties and approximately 22 electors.
2. **Petersfield Crescent** move from Old Coulsdon to Coulsdon Town.
Reason: The present boundary means that Hillars Heath and Asmar Close and the main part of Coulsdon Woods estate are separated from the rest of Coulsdon Town. Moving Petersfield Crescent into Coulsdon Town means there is a physical connection between Stoats Nest Road and these roads. This affects 16 properties and approximately 33 electors.
