

Brexit Health Check

- Do you have an EORI number?
- Who will arrange customs declarations at both origin and destination? Do consider making an application for TSP if you have not done so already, as this procedure will enable most imported goods to be brought into the UK without the need to declare them to HMRC first.
- Can your EU carriers provide the necessary transit guarantees?
- Will your business be able to produce customs data in a timely manner to meet your supply chain demands? Can this data be produced in an automated form to minimise re-keying of information?
- Will your suppliers be able to provide customs data in a timely manner to meet your supply chain demands?
- Review the incoterms used for EU movements and the customs obligations your company has to customs clearance arrangements, costs and import duty
- For sales to EU member states, consider the cost implications of EU duty to your clients on your sales value
- If you purchase EU goods on a delivered basis, do your suppliers have arrangements in place to deal with the issues which Brexit will bring?
- Check whether your exports to the EU use wood packing
- Consider the impact of postponed accounting of VAT on your cash flow for all imports from both EU and non-EU countries
- Review options to move freight to and from the EU using alternative routes avoiding the short sea channel crossings
- For internet sales and other regular despatches to the EU, consider establishing a hub in an EU member state and consider the VAT implications at destination for B2B sold DDP
- Has your business taken any action to protect itself against currency fluctuations?
