At the end of the week, your parents, carers or people who work with you are invited to attend your passing out ceremony to showcase the amazing skills you have learned.

This course will help you to:

- Achieve things you never thought you could do.
- Build your confidence and self-esteem.
- Improve your team work and leadership skills.
- Get a portfolio of achievement.
