Introduction

This procedure supports Resuscitation Council (UK) Guidelines 2015 and supports decision making of staff to provide appropriate emergency care for patients in the event of a medical emergency or cardiac arrest at the Primary Care Centre (PCC). All frontline staff are trained in resuscitation measures, including the use of an AED, in accordance with current UK resuscitation guidelines.

All PCCs have the equipment and emergency drugs for critical conditions and interventions including:

- Cardiac Arrest
- Anaphylaxis
- Meningococcal disease
- Status asthmaticus
- Status epilepticus

Please note that all Primary Care Centres have their own local arrangements for patient transfers.
