Introduction

This procedure outlines the use of the DISA (Direct Inward System Access) facility. DISA is a telephone recording system that can be used for outbound calls from Badger staff to patients or external agencies from any of our centres or while home working, excluding Glover Street or Aston Bourne Road (ABR). Calls from Glover Street or ABR are automatically recorded by Badger's internal phone system.

DISA ensures secure call recordings for patient and external agency conversations, promoting data protection and information security. It is important to consider that call recordings may be requested at a later date for medico-legal purposes, highlighting the importance of accurate documentation.

Instructions for using DISA

- 1. DISA routes all calls through Badger phone system
- 2. All calls are recorded
- 3. Can be used from any telephone, mobile or landline
- 4. 0800 number used therefore no cost unless the network charges for 0800 numbers
