Background

From 1st April 2004, BADGER has provided an out of hours service to the prison healthcare department.

The prison accommodates approximately 1,450 category B, male prisoners aged 21 plus.

It is anticipated that most calls will be for advice only. Call volumes are expected to be low, typically 5 calls per month; the number of visits will be minimal.

Hours of Cover

Cover will be provided at the following times:

- 21:00 to 08:30 hours Monday to Friday
- All day Saturday & Sunday and bank holidays.

REPORTING

Calls will be usually be made by a prison nurse; the nurse will have done the initial observations.

VISITS

If a visit is required, the details of the Doctor, the driver and the vehicle, must be provided to the Nurse.

The driver must only be a BADGER driver; agency drivers should not be used.

Driver and Doctor must carry BADGER photo ID card.

On arrival at the prison report to the main gate in Winson Green Road.

The driver will remain with the vehicle at all times.

DEATH

To carry out Recognition of Death (R.O.D) a visit will be required.
