## Introduction

This procedure provides the details of pharmacists that supply palliative care drugs in the Birmingham, Solihull Sandwell, Dudley, and Wolverhampton area.

## Specialist Palliative Care Drugs (SPCD) - Network of Pharmacies

SPCD is a local enhanced service commissioned by four local clinical commission groups across the West Midlands.

Pharmacies will hold agreed stocks of SPCD drugs and dispense palliative care prescriptions.

The aim of this service is to provide a network of community pharmacies.

### **BADGER Stock**

BADGER holds a small emergency stock of palliative care drugs (Diamorphine) for use by visiting doctors to give to patients in their own homes.

# **Dispensing to other Health Care Professionals**

BADGER does not act as a dispensary to nurse or other medical prescribers and does not have a licence to dispense these drugs for other parties.

Other healthcare professionals requesting the supply of these drugs should be advised to contact one of the pharmacies listed on the enclosed circular from the network or advised to go to the pharmacy at City or Heartlands hospital.
