BISHOP BURTON BURIAL REGISTERS 1752-1767

The registers cover the "church" years 1752- 1767. Before 1752 these years ran from Easter to Easter. From 1752 the years run from January to December.

Most of the entries conclude with the phrase "affidavit brought" or an abbreviation ot it. During 1666 - 1680, The Burial in Woollen Acts required that the dead should be buried in shrouds of pure wool. This excluded plague victims.

Also, an affidavit had to sworn in front of a Justice of the Peace confirming that the body had been buried in wool. There was a penalty of £5 if any other material was used. The incumbent would then write the word affidavit, or note A or Aff against the relevant entry in the Parish Register. If a family were poor and could not afford a woollen shroud, the entry in the register may have the word 'naked' written in it.

The law stayed in force until 1814 but was usually ignored after 1770.
