- The Managing Director and Top Management will demonstrate and lead by example the willingness to implement and follow the standards as laid out by the business management system and take full accountability for the results and compliance achieved
- Top Management will ensure the compliance in regulating the environmental performance of RHNL and operating within the requirements of the standard, GB and European directives
- RHNL ensures this policy is understood, implemented and maintained at all levels within the organization and proportionate resources are available to execute the policy
- Educate and empower the workforce in environmental awareness and promote ownership of environmental responsibilities and communicate information on a periodic basis
- Ensuring all our business partners are aware of the potential environmental effects of their activities and advise of the benefits from improving environmental standards
- Comply with the EPA90 and applicable further regulation and guidance, have appropriate consents in place and follow codes issued at European, national and local levels and adopt a proactive approach to future environmental requirements
- Minimizing waste wherever possible and where waste is inevitable. Ensuring we segregate at source thus reuse or recycle rather than dispose to landfill where practicable
- Monitor our energy usage and seek to reduce the energy required to power our business
- In maintaining our systems of work to remain compliant, continual improvements shall be made via the PDCA model of performance and metrics recorded to identify improvements
- Committed to continually improving our environmental performance and prevention of pollution by annually setting reduction targets and objectives remaining transparent to our stakeholders and any other interested parties
- Reduce emissions to air by improving the management, control and scheduling of the works fleet vehicles; proportionally reduce the carbon tyre print and vehicle emissions by use of smarter technology - lower emission vehicles best available at the time (BATNEEC)
