

10 Top tips for Zoom church

1. Remember that you being there is a huge, huge **encouragement** to others- so do keep logging on (no need to say anything if you don't want to.)
2. Remember: **don't be embarrassed** - it's strange for all of us!
3. Join before the scheduled **start time** to say hello to others and get ready.
4. **Kids** - Encourage your parents to print your activity sheet ahead of time.
5. Choose **gallery view** at the top right of your screen. This means the current speaker won't keep on jumping to the front and you'll see lots of people.
6. Keep **an eye on the screen** where you'll see the service order.
7. **Mute yourself** at the bottom left of your screen. This means you can sing and pray along without others hearing you.
8. If you're still wearing your pyjamas, **stop your video!**
9. Please stay for **coffee time** at the end. We'll split into randomly assigned virtual breakout rooms to chat. At the very end, we'll come together for a final prayer.
10. You can **leave the meeting** (bottom right hand corner) at the end of coffee time, or you can stay and keep chatting!
