Item 3: Brexit-themed Conference on 17 December

1.3 The Chair outlined plans for a proposed joint Brexit-themed conference with Cambridge University. The purpose of the conference would be to discuss the technical implications of Brexit in England and Wales. The conference would consider constitutional issues related to the legislative process and then look at a few specific issues or sectors in more detail. The Board agreed that attendance should be formed of academics, civil servants, commentators and others from NGOs or similar organisations.
