### **Build strong relationships and social networks**

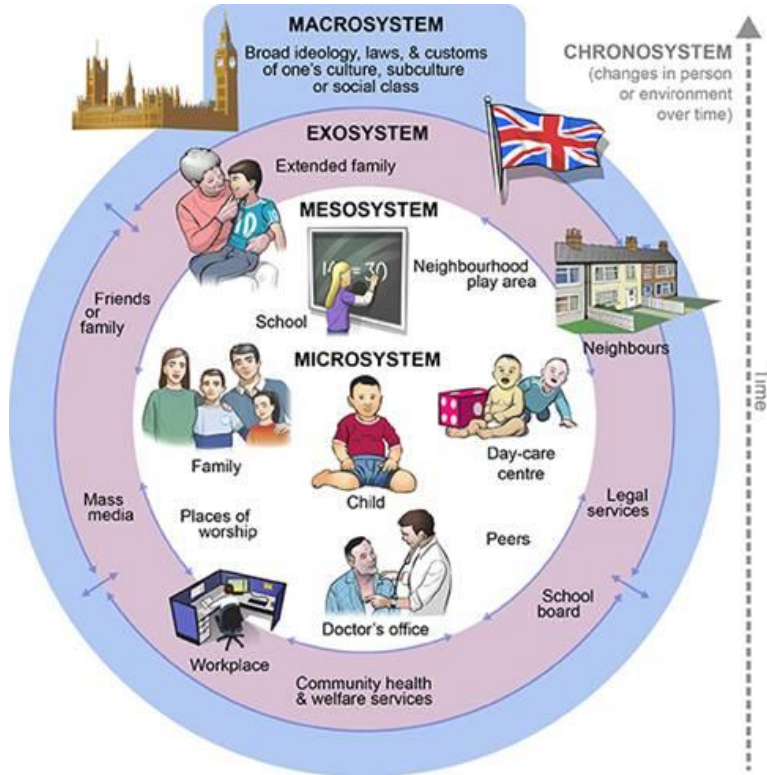
