MASTERPLAN EXHIBITION LAUNCH: A NEW CENTRE

Over the past two years we have been working alongside the community to help develop our plans for the Lewisham Shopping Centre.

Read below to find out more about the proposals.

A New Park

A new public park will be the crowning glory of our proposed multi-level public realm. Based around a meadow concept, the park will be set above the hustle and bustle of the shopping centre and high street, and will include new play and rest and relaxation opportunities for visitors.

Places to Walk, Gather and Relax

New and improved walking routes will better connect the town centre and wider area, creating a safer environment for pedestrians and shoppers. The proposed plans also include a public square and smaller spaces to gather and celebrate all the centre has to offer.

A New Shopping Centre Fit for the Future

At the heart of the scheme sits Lewisham Shopping Centre. We will re-provide a covered shopping centre with a diverse offer of shops surrounded by open streets and public realm. The plans will help transform and support the High Street and the market as well as create jobs locally.

A Music Venue

Our aspiration is to amplify Lewisham's past and present culture with a new venue for music. If you want to know more about the town centre's history of music and popular culture, come visit us at the shopping centre.

New Homes

We will be delivering up to 1,700 homes including affordable housing. We'll also be creating additional homes for shared living and students within the masterplan.

A Cultural Hub

A new cultural hub will be a space for communities and groups to hire for a range of events or meetings.



The Exhibition

The exhibition will feature a display of the history of Lewisham town centre through the centuries and Goldsmiths University's In Living Memory Project. We will be showcasing our work with different community groups and how this informed the masterplan. We will be sharing plans for the new shopping centre, including proposals for a new public park at the heart of the town centre, and play and civic spaces. The plan will include new shops, restaurants, bars and homes.

In Living Memory Comes to Lewisham Shopping Centre

As a part of Goldsmiths University In Living Memory project, a temporary window display will feature on the former Wilko store windows. It will explore post-war Lewisham through stories of community-led projects from black-led self-build movement, lost gay venues, protests, the flood of 1968, textile workers from the Windrush generation, and the campaign to keep Lewisham Hospital open.
