New segregated bus provision will be introduced on Furnival Gate alongside a new, improved green walking link and two-way cycle route.

Along Arundel Gate, meandering cycleways and footpaths will be set within a diverse green landscape. This will create an attractive and safe environment for walking and cycling, and a space where people can sit and enjoy the outdoors.

Additional bus stops will be added along Furnival Gate and a bus gate will be introduced to improve access into the city centre for buses while reducing general traffic in key civic areas.

On Arundel Gate, access via car will be limited to one-way westbound between Castle Square and Furnival Gate roundabout. This will ease congestion and give buses priority. Eastbound, car access on Arundel Gate will be restricted beyond the access road to the Novotel Hotel. Access to car parks will be maintained.

At Furnival Square, the removal of the existing roundabout will create a new gateway into the city centre for all modes of transport. A new walking and cycling route will be created alongside a small city centre pocket park to provide welcome green space.
