Nether Edge - City Centre: Sharrow Lane area

A two-way cycle track would be created along the west side of Washington Road between Mackenzie Street and Sharrow Lane.

Building the cycle track is likely to require the removal of a small number of trees. The proposed layout would keep this to an absolute minimum. Any trees that do have to be removed would be replaced with specimens of a similar or higher standard. Other improvements would also be made to the green spaces.

The proposed layout would allow the majority of on-street parking places on Washington Road to be retained. Use of these spaces would be for resident permit holders only.

The traffic lights at the junction of Washington Road and Wostenholm Road with Sharrow Lane would be altered to accommodate the two-way cycle track.

The end of Priory Road would be closed (except for cyclists) to contribute towards establishing an Active Neighbourhood.

A segregated two-way cycle-only track would be built in front of Wostenholm Road shops. One parking space would be lost from the bay.

To the south of the shops, the footway on the west side of Wostenholm Road would be widened as far as Priory Place. No parking would be allowed on this side so that the footway could be made wide enough for both cyclists and pedestrians.
