Notification

High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. We are continually reviewing the works on our construction sites in line with Government and Public Health England (PHE) advice on dealing with COVID-19. The Government's current strategy makes it clear that construction activity can continue as long as it complies with this guidance. Please be assured that only sites that can operate within the guidelines are operational. All sites will remain under constant review. What are we doing?

As part of our preparatory works, we are continuing with our Ground Investigation (GI) and utility works. As part of this we need to carry out some utility trial holes. Some of these works will need to be carried out on or adjacent to the carriageways in the area, therefore there are some anticipated dates that some short duration traffic management will need to be in place.

When will these works take place?

The works will commence from November and continue into January 2021.

Below are the locations and intended dates of where and when the traffic management and diversions will be in place.

- 1. A413 London Road 14.12.20 18.12.20
- 2. Bacombe Lane 10.12.20 and 14.01.21
- 3. Ellesborough Road 15.01.20 22.01.21
- 4. Old Risborough Road 11.12.20
- 5. Risborough Road 07.01.21 19.01.21 (Works to be completed
- 6. Rocky Lane 09.12.20 and 18.12.21

The timings of the works may differ depending on what we find as well as other external conditions such as the weather. We will work to reduce disruption where possible.

What to expect: A road closure for the duration of the works, with a diversion in place. There will be local access allowed for residents.




The map above details the works location and diversion route.






Location 6 – Rocky Lane
