



Notice of Construction Works in Mixbury

High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. We are writing to make you aware of the next stage of work that will be undertaken by Western Power Distribution (WPD) on our behalf.

What are we doing

In order to construct the railway we need to relocate the 132kV overhead line and pylons that cross the HS2 route at Tibbetts Farm, Featherbed Lane.

We will be working along the entire 132kV overhead line from the A421 to the great river Ouse and our site compound will be in a field, off Featherbed Lane adjacent to Tibbetts Farm. We will be installing a new cable from one side of HS2 route, via directional underground drilling, to the other and connect the overhead line to this new cable. The result will be the removal of two large lattice pylons.

How will this affect me?

For large deliveries the access route is off the A421 along Featherbed Lane. During a busy phase of works there will be up to 4 Heavy Goods Vehicles (HGVs) per day and/or up to 4 small lorries per day. At all other times you may notice our staff coming to and from site in cars, vans or 4x4s. We will need to bring 2 concrete lorries to site per day for approx. 5 Weeks excluding weekends. There will be no Heavy Goods vehicle at weekends and all HGV movements will be carried out from 09.30 to 15.30. To reduce our impact on the local road network we will try to cluster deliveries together, to minimise any disturbance.

The normal working hours for this will be:

Monday – Friday 07.30 to 17.30 (excluding weekend and Bank Holidays)

Between August and October we will be on site 07.30 to 19.30; working 10 days on and 2 days off

Please note that we will have a second access route to gain access to the southerly towers via Warren Farm off the A421
