

Closure of Tilehouse Lane, West Hyde

High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. We are continually reviewing the works on our construction sites in line with Government and Public Health England (PHE) advice on dealing with Covid-19. The Government's current strategy makes it clear that construction activity can continue as long as it complies with this guidance. Please be assured that only sites that can operate within the guidelines are operational. All sites remain under constant review.

We wrote to residents in October last year to explain that we were closing public footpath DEN3/1 and diverting the public right of way at Old Shire Lane, Denham in advance of works in the area to the south of our main works site in West Hyde.

Closure of Tilehouse Lane to build a new bridge

From 24 January 2021 the northern section of Tilehouse Lane, between Denham and West Hyde, will be closed. The road closure will be in place for approximately 6 months.

To build the Colne Valley Viaduct next year we are realigning a section of Tilehouse Lane and building an overbridge which will allow us to permanently divert local traffic on Tilehouse Lane over the railway.

To do this we must close the northern section of Tilehouse Lane to all traffic from the junction of Tilehouse Lane with A412 / Denham Way to the junction with Denham Green Lane.

Access for businesses and residents

Access will be maintained at all times to Tilehouse Lane businesses and residents from the southern end of Tilehouse Lane at the junction with Denham Green Lane. Signage will be installed to advise visitors and customers that access to businesses and properties is open, along with diversion signs at the main points of access.

These works will continue until July 2021. For the details of the closure and the diversion points, please see the map overleaf.
