Update: Further works on Adelaide Road

High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain.

We are continually reviewing the works on our construction sites in line with Government and Public Health England (PHE) advice on dealing with COVID-19. The Government's current strategy makes it clear that construction activity can continue as long as it complies with this guidance. Please be assured that only sites that can work within the guidelines are operational. All sites will remain under constant review.

Further works on the Adelaide Road site boundary

From mid-March until late-June 2021, we will be carrying out essential works to continue setting up our Adelaide Road site boundary. These works include:

- Gates installation
- Site access ramp
- Installation of bulk timbers on the hoarding
- Hoarding lighting

Temporary traffic management on Adelaide Road

To carry out these works safely, we will require five short, temporary lane closures next to our site. The works will be carried out in five phases and we will use temporary traffic lights to minimise disruption to local residents and road users.

The location of these works is shown on the map overleaf.

The phases of the lane closures and the dates for these works may change. We will provide further updates at hs2incamden.co.uk

Duration of works

From mid-March to late-June 2021

Our working hours are 8am to 6pm, Monday to Friday, and 8am to 1pm Saturdays if required

We may be on site for an hour before the start and/or end of each shift

What to expect

Short term lane closures and traffic management will be required in phases on Adelaide Road

What we will do

Where possible, measures such as acoustic barriers, the use of handheld tools and dampening down of dust will be in place to reduce any disruption to residents
