HS2 Update 01 December 2020

Planned engagement for 2021

We are working with our contractors to put in place our engagement plan for next year; to ensure that we are sharing information regularly, through a range of formats, and enabling opportunities for members of the community to ask us questions, in line with the local engagement plan.

New / restarted routine engagement in 2021

- Construction look aheads published quarterly covering the next three months. These will also include a less detailed look ahead for work over the next 12 months (first publication 1 December 2020).
- Regular Camden wide newsletters delivered to residents; to include:
 - Outline of upcoming works and events including help promote the quarterly construction look aheads;
 - Local projects; and
 - Signposting to further information (including noise insulation, skills education and employment activities, and community investment programmes, other organisations' information such as Network Rail).
- (While Covid restrictions continue) monthly interactive virtual engagement opportunities (webinars and virtual drop-ins) on a range of topics.
- (When Covid restrictions end) monthly physical drop-ins / surgeries and topic specific talks.

Engagement updates

Further engagement projects are being scheduled at the moment. These will include:

Specific topic or planned works will receive dedicated engagement / communications programmes. For example, dedicated engagement around the construction skills centre at the proposed worker accommodation site on the former Maria Fidelis school playground.

Review of the Local Area Engagement Plan underway

Review focused on updating technical detail, personnel and contact information. Contact group input to be sought.

Website update

In order to improve the quality of our online offering, HS2 is transferring the HS2 in Camden (and all it's other local sites) from Commonplace to its own systems. No functionality or information will be lost, however we hope that it will enable us to implement more functionality such as an interactive map of HS2 works in the area and improve usability.


Post-Covid and inclusivity


Adelaide Road Vent Shaft – works update











Programme Update

- **Cubitt Court and Tintern House** have recently triggered and all noise insulation works for which we were given access have been completed in these locations.
- New subcontractor (Adept) installing mechanical ventilation in all *non*-listed properties with 85 properties closed out since the beginning of September, and a current focus on Cartmel, Coniston and Langdale.
- **New subcontractor (Selectaglaze)** started on site 25-Nov-20 replacing Everest who went into administration during the first COVID-19 lockdown.
- **Some delays** finalising the contract with the new subcontractor that will install mechanical ventilation in listed buildings. Plans to have them in contract by mid-December.
- Ampthill high rise design almost complete pending information to be provided by Camden.




Adelaide Road Vent Shaft Site

Design developments





During the first phase of scheme design in late 2017, the headhouse configuration was reviewed and horizontal fans within the headhouse, instead of vertically aligned fans were introduced. The shaft is smaller, reducing the amount of excavation and the associated lorry movements.

The structure could then be repositioned within the permanent compound. This allows a continuous boundary wall, instead of the building being part of the boundary, giving a less industrial feel, and also enabling a planting area to both the road side and rails side frontages

Scheme design to date

- The early scheme design (or outline design) for the head house structure was shared at the initial design engagement in summer 2018.
- Detailed design is now underway

 Additional engagement events will be held on the proposed building design, to include the boundary on Adelaide Road




Indicative view from Adelaide Road




This extract shows the work in progress (up to Nov'19) on the landscape plan, using the graded landscape principle (as before).

The main area of planting (shaded in orange, approx. 0.12 hectares*) within the overall headhouse compound will be maintained within the permanent site boundary (dotted red line) of approximately 0.31 hectares*. Overall mitigation area, including soft landscaping within the grey compound area is currently at approx. 0.155 hectares*

The area shaded pink (and any additional temporary land take) will be returned to the landowner, Network Rail, and will also be replanted as part of the site restoration scheme.



- There will be no stockpiling of felled timber on site.
- Very limited stockpiling of excavated material will take place on the site, material will be removed as early as possible after excavation
