# Completion of pipeline diversion works near Harvil Road, Harefield

High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. The Government's current strategy sets out that during the COVID-19 outbreak construction activity should continue, as long as work can comply with Government and Public Health England guidance. We will be keeping our local website, [www.hs2inillingdon.co.uk](http://www.hs2inillingdon.co.uk) up to date with information on our works, and the measures we have in place to maintain the safety of the community and our workforce.

Since the start of 2019, Cadent has been working to move an existing gas pipeline near Harvil Road, Harefield, to facilitate the construction of HS2 and to continue to ensure a safe and reliable gas supply.

## What is happening

We have now finished moving the pipe and have successfully carried out routine testing on the relocated pipeline. We're currently reinstating our working areas on either side of Harvil Road to replace topsoil and vegetation that we had to remove to carry out the diversion.

The compound and carpark west of Harvil Road and the site accesses off Harvil Road will remain as they will be used by other HS2 works in the future.

We expect that all Cadent work at this site will be completed by mid-December 2020.

We would like to thank local residents for their continued patience throughout the duration of our work.

## How will this affect you?

You may still see people and equipment on site as we complete the final stages of our reinstatement works.

We will continue to keep people up to date as other HS2 works in the area progress.

- All work expected to be complete by mid-December 2020
- Our core working hours will be 8.00am to 6.00pm (Mon-Fri) and 8.00am to 1.00pm (Sat)
- We will be onsite one hour either side of these times for set-up and close-down

- You may still see people and equipment on site until work is complete in mid-December 2020
- Utility supplies in the area will not be affected

## What we will do

- Make sure there is minimal disruption to local residents
- Make sure all construction vehicles use agreed routes
- Maintain a safe working environment

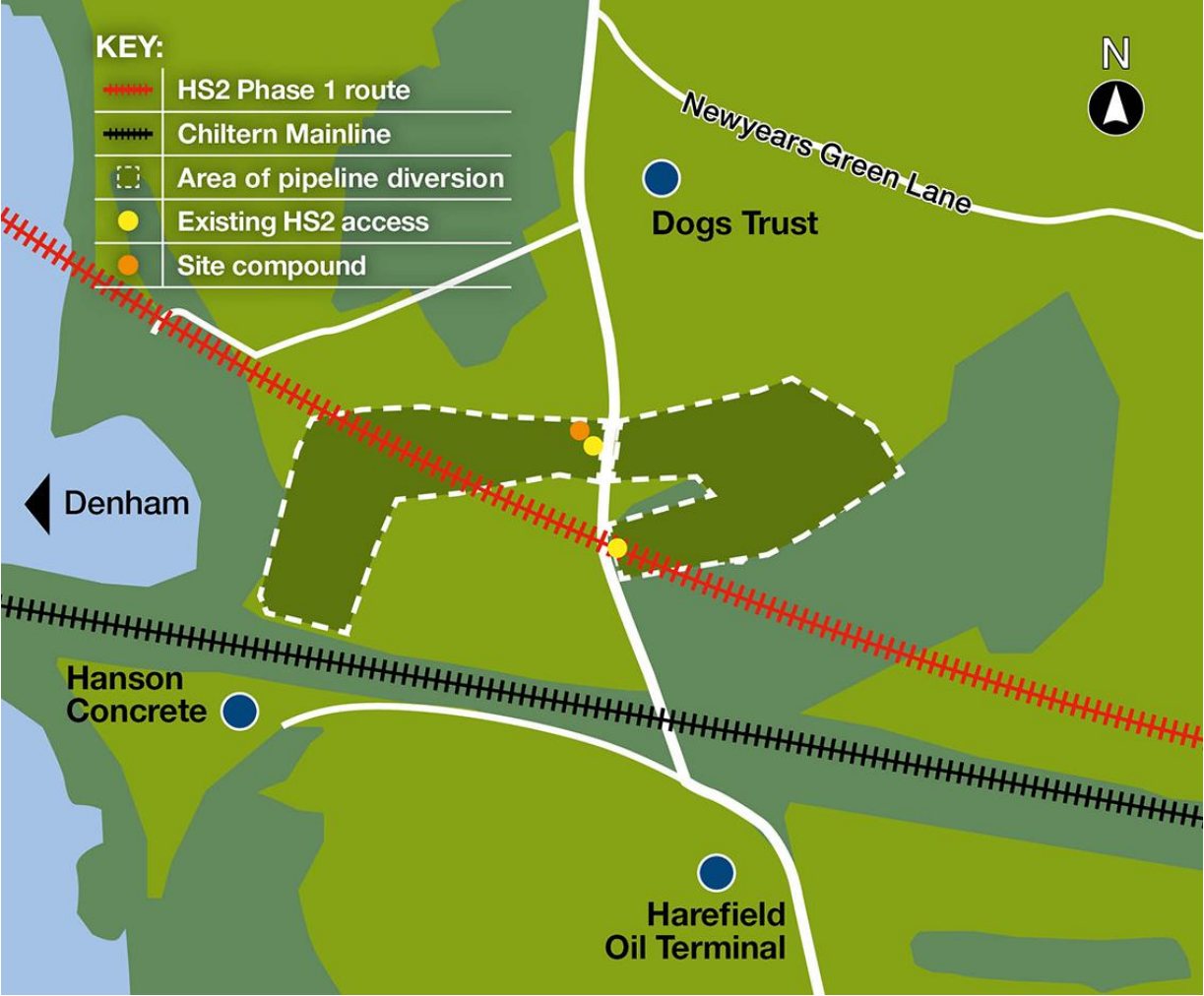
