## Notice of overnight road closures and 24-hour lane closures on the A452 and A446

High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. Early works for HS2 are carried out by a joint venture between Laing O'Rourke and J. Murphy & Sons known as LM. In your area, we are working near the A452, A45 and M42, which surround the site of the future HS2 Interchange Station.

### We're improving the local road network

When the future HS2 Interchange Station is operational, four new highways bridges will connect the current road network to new routes we are creating. The first of these new highways bridges was safely installed in August 2020 over the M42, and the second was installed in October 2020 over the A446. This year, we will carry out various activities to fully reinstate these roads such as drainage connections.

### We'll be starting work on Monday 8 February

To carry out this work safely, we will install:

- Temporary, overnight road closures along the A452 and A446 from 8pm to 6am, from Monday 8 February to Friday 12 February, and then from 8pm to 6am, from Monday 15 February to Tuesday 16 February (see map 1 on page 2)
- 24-hour single lane closures along the A446 from Monday 8 February to Wednesday 10 February (see map 2 on page 3)
- 24-hour single lane closures along the A452 from Monday 8 February to Monday 15 February (see map 3 on page 3)

### HS2 during the coronavirus pandemic

We are continually reviewing the works on our construction sites in line with Government and Public Health England (PHE) advice on dealing with coronavirus. The Government's current strategy makes clear that construction activity can continue if it complies with this guidance.

The health and safety of our workforce and the communities we affect is our key priority. Please be assured that those sites that are currently still working are doing so because they can operate within PHE and construction industry guidelines.

A combination of overnight road closures and 24-hour lane closures will be installed from Monday 8 February to Tuesday 16 February on the A452 and A446.

### What to expect

Our contractors may be on site up to an hour before and after those times to set up and close down the site.

Signed diversion routes will be in place for drivers during these overnight road closures.

### What we will do

Keep all sites safe and secure.

Leave the area in a tidy state when works are complete.

Maintain access to all buildings and businesses in the area.

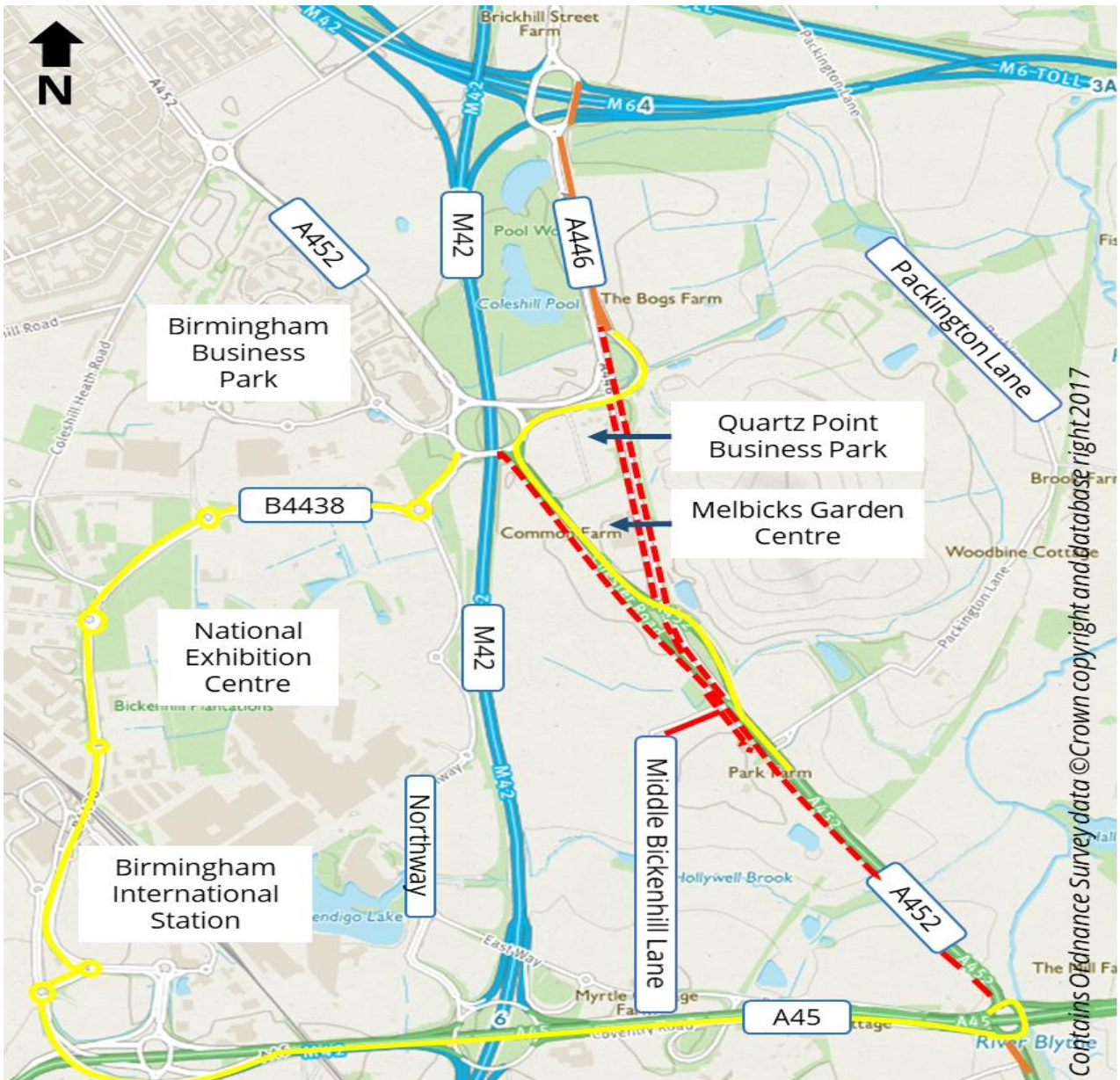

-  = permanent road closure

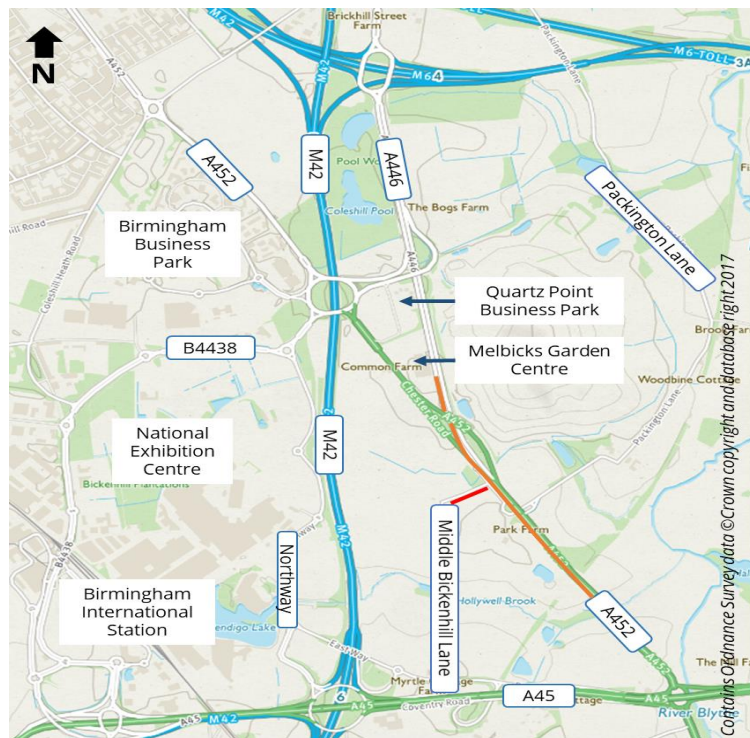


## Map 3 - location of 24-hour single lane closures along the A452
