## Work will we be completing

In June this year we sent out a notification to outline work we are completing in our compound area off Coleshill Heath Road. To help continue with these works, we will be implementing temporary traffic lights on Coleshill Heath Road from **19<sup>th</sup> October 2020**.

The temporary traffic lights will be in place 9:30am – 3:30pm, Monday – Friday for two weeks until **Friday 30<sup>th</sup> October**. The temporary traffic lights will enable our contractors to complete utility surveys and the enabling works for our compound in the area.

Once this work is finished, the traffic lights will be taken down. We then continue to work from this compound for the duration of the project. There may be other times we need to implement traffic management onto Coleshill Heath Road. 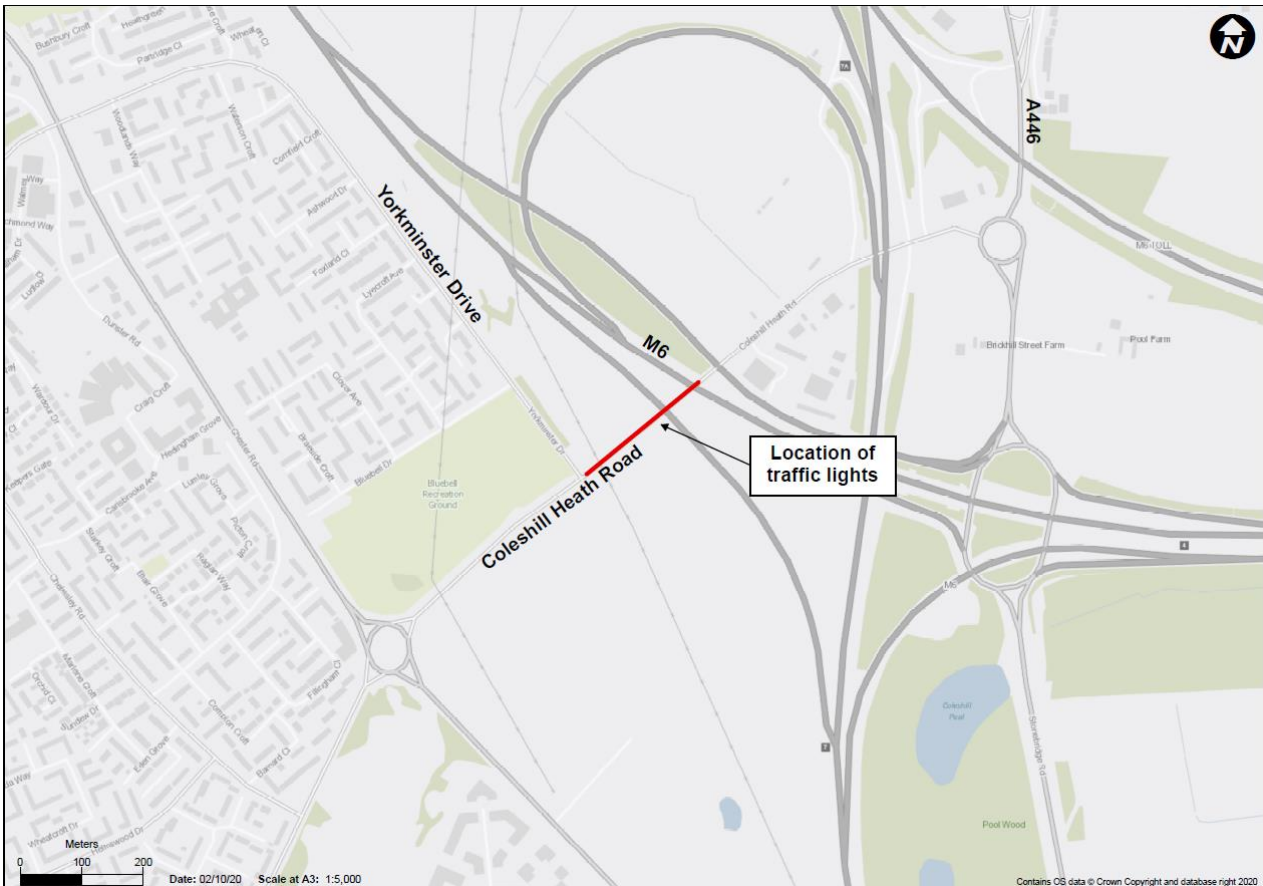
