Notice of traffic management in Berkswell and Balsall Common

High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. Early works for HS2 are carried out by LM – a joint venture between Laing O'Rourke and J. Murphy & Sons.

Over the coming months, we'll be working near Berkswell and Balsall Common to prepare the route for the new railway ahead of main works construction. This includes vegetation and some tree clearance.

Where the temporary traffic lights will be

LM will be working alongside Lavender Hall Lane and Park Lane to clear vegetation along the road and will need to operate temporary traffic lights to create a safe working zone. These signals will be in operation between **9:30am-3:30pm** from the week commencing **27th January** for three weeks, subject to site and weather conditions.

Where the road closure will be

We will be closing a section of Truggist Lane during the day to create a safe zone for accessing our work site.

The closure will be in place between **9:30 and 15:30** on week days from **27th January** for around three weeks (subject to site and weather conditions). Please see the map on overleaf. While this section is closed a diversion route will be in operation along Station Road, Kenilworth Road, Kelsey Lane, Waste Lane, Nailcote Lane and Spencer's Lane.

Marshalls will escort pedestrians safely through the works.

Why we're doing this work

We need to prepare as much of the route as possible over the coming months. This will ensure that our main construction work can commence on time. It is also important to complete this work during this time of year as it is outside of key periods in the ecological calendar and helps to minimise our impact on local wildlife.

From the week commencing 27th January for three weeks.

Our teams will be on site up to one hour before and after the works take place.

Ensure road closure and diversion routes are clearly marked.
