Temporary overnight closures – Stoneleigh Road & Chesford Junction

High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. Early works for HS2 are now underway in your area, carried out by LM – a joint venture between Laing O’Rourke and J. Murphy & Sons.

LM will be carrying out overnight surveys on Stoneleigh Road and around the Chesford Junction to gather information required for future works. To ensure safety during the surveys Stoneleigh Road will be temporarily closed on the 20th January 2020 for one night. The B4115 Ashow Road will then be temporarily closed at Chesford Junction from the 21st January until 25th January 2020 and then again for one night on the 28th January 2020, subject to site conditions.

A diversion will be in place for each closure, with signs on the road indicating the diversion route. Closures will be lifted during the day.
