High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. Initial works have now started and are carried out by LM – a joint venture between Laing O'Rourke and J. Murphy & Sons.

Road closure required

We sincerely apologise for the late notice, however, we are writing to advise that LM needs to undertake some urgent works to repair a manufacturing fault within a cable joint on Bascote Road as part of the TBM utility works. This means that Bascote Road will need to be closed from Friday 12 February for 5 days between the Welsh Road junction and the A425 (please see map).

Access will still be maintained for households and businesses along the road and a clearly signposted diversion will be in place. All traffic management will be lifted once works are complete.

We would like to thank you for your understanding and patience during these works and please accept our apologies again for any inconvenience caused.

Works are subject to consent, site and weather conditions. Dates may also be subject to change.

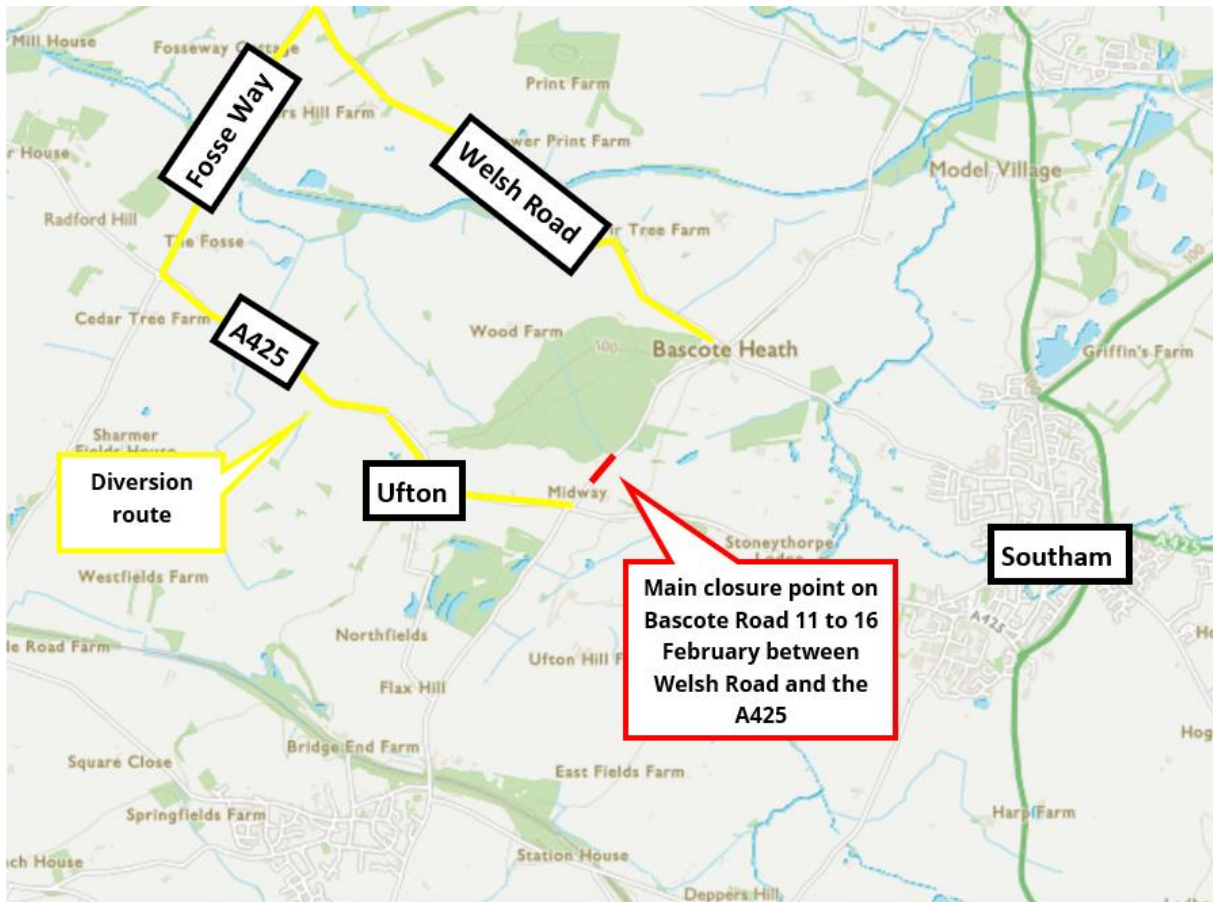
