

# Notice of Traffic Management and Ground Investigation Surveys – A425 Leamington Road (Ufton Hill)



High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. Balfour Beatty Vinci is working on behalf of HS2 Ltd to build the new high-speed railway in your area.

## Information about HS2 construction works during the coronavirus (COVID-19) pandemic

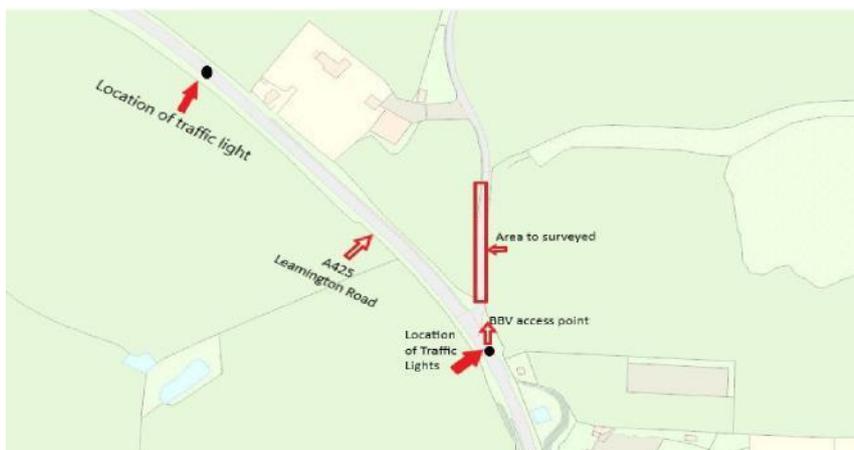
We are continually reviewing the works on our construction sites in line with Government and Public Health England (PHE) advice on dealing with COVID-19. The Government’s current COVID-19 strategy makes clear that construction activity can continue as long as it complies with this guidance. The health and safety of our workforce and the communities we affect is our key priority. Please be assured that those sites that are currently still working are doing so because they can operate within PHE and construction industry guidelines.

### What work will we be doing?

We will be undertaking ground investigation surveys, which will help us to finalise the design for the route to be constructed. These surveys will be carried out on Ridgeway lane from the junction of the A425 Ufton Hill. To complete the works in a safe environment, we will be installing traffic lights on Leamington Road (A425) on the 29<sup>th</sup> May. This will be during off-peak hours and in place for one day only.

### Where will the surveys be taking place?

The surveys will be taking place in the area outlined below. Also outlined is our access point and the location of the traffic lights on the A425, Leamington Road (Ufton Hill).

### Duration of works

- Two way traffic management will be in place on 29 May 2020 between 9.30am until 3.30pm.
- Traffic management is planned for one day.
- Our working hours will be 9:30am until 3:30pm.
- Our workforce will be on site 1 hour before and after to set up and take down our work equipment.

### What to expect

- Two-way traffic lights
- Installation of signage on the A425 and Ridgeway Lane.
- A potential increase in noise from the work we are completing.
