Notice of traffic management in Stoneleigh and Ashow

High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. Early works for HS2 are now underway in your area, carried out by LM – a joint venture between Laing O’Rourke and J. Murphy & Sons.

The work outlined in this notice may be subject to changes and consents. Maps are included on the following pages.

Temporary night road closures in Stoneleigh

LM will be surveying roads around Stoneleigh and Ashow in July 2020. For the safety of everyone in the area, we will need to temporarily close and divert sections of roads **from 8.00pm to 6.00am the following day.**

Stoneleigh Road	A46 to Birmingham Road/B4115	Sunday 12 July to Wednesday 15 July
Birmingham Road	Stoneleigh Road/B4115 to Stoneleigh Close	Thursday 16 July, Sunday 19 July and Monday 20 July
Birmingham Road	Hall Close to B4113 Coventry Road	Tuesday 21 July and Wednesday 22 July
Coventry Road	Stoneleigh Bridge	Thursday 23 July

Survey along B4115 supported by moving traffic lights

We will also be surveying B4115 Ashow Road, moving in phases along the road, for **three days from Monday 6 July 2020.** The survey will help HS2 understand the conditions and ecology of the road, to help finalise plans for future work on the B4115 during main works.

A rolling work site for the survey will be supported by temporary traffic lights – sometimes two-way, sometimes three-way – on the B4115 **between Stoneleigh Road/Birmingham Road, and the junction of B4115 and A452 Leamington Road/Kenilworth Road.** Access through lights will be maintained. They will move along the road, changing position each day, to support surveyors.

Keep disruptions to a minimum and maintain access to properties.

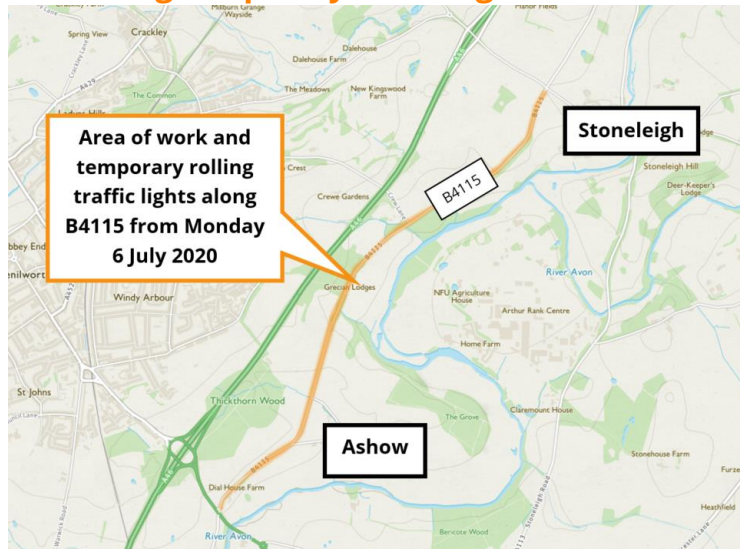
Ensure **one.network** is updated with traffic management details.

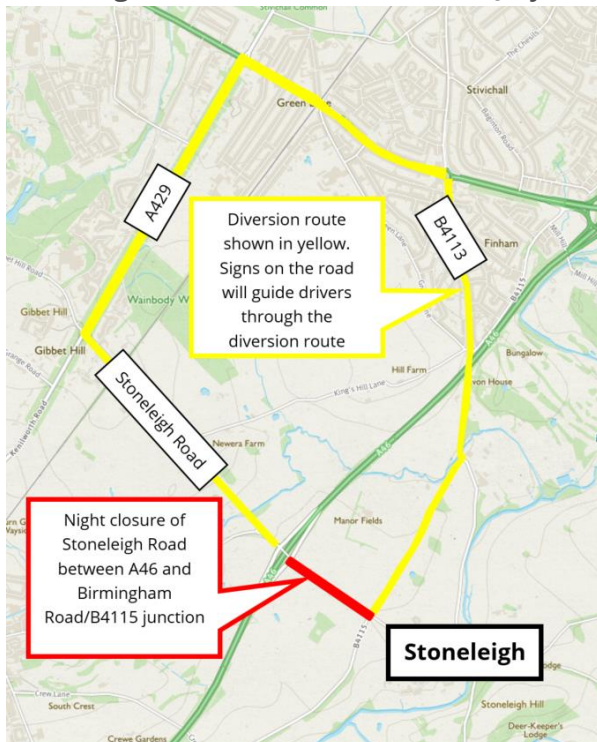

Stoneleigh Road closure from 12–15 July



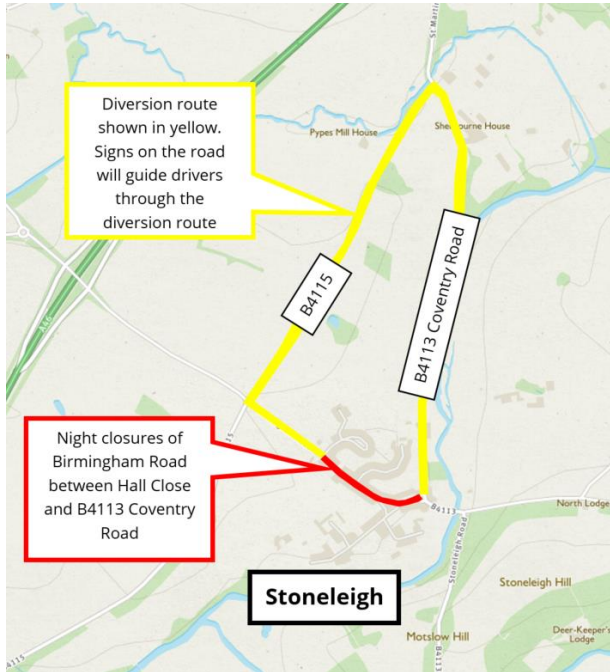
Birmingham Road closure on 16, 19, 20 July

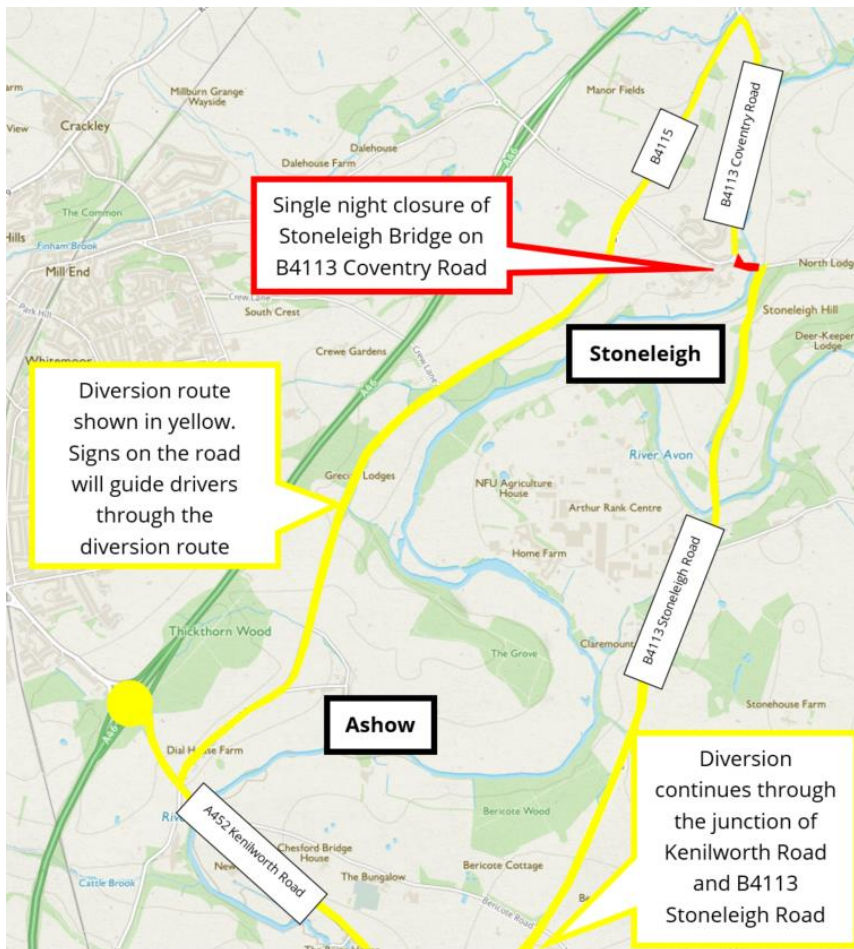
