Notice of daytime closure Red Lane, Burton Green

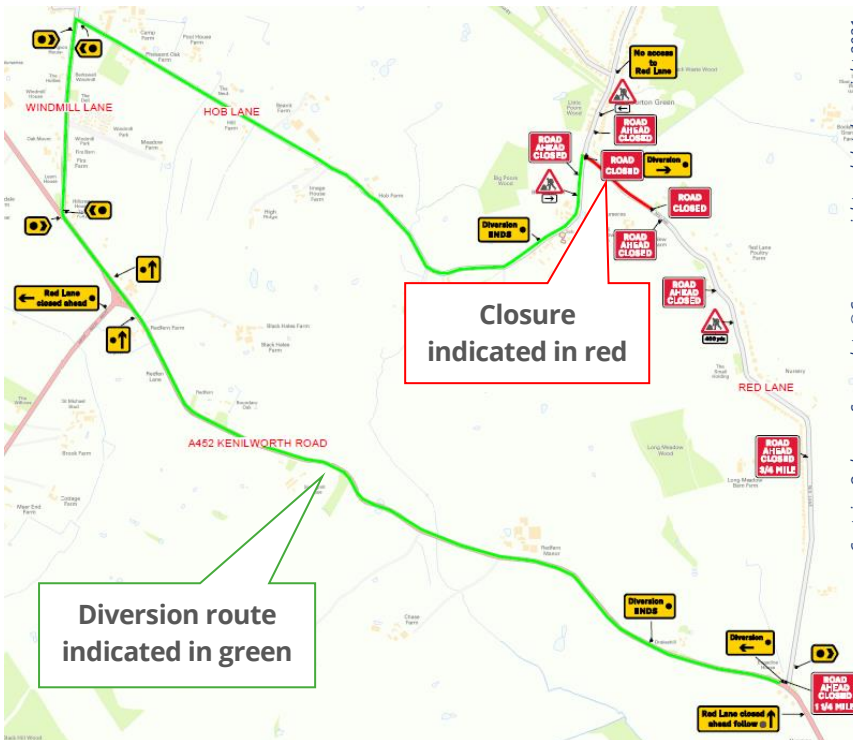

High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. HS2 early works for your area are carried out by LM – a joint venture between Laing O’Rourke and J. Murphy & Sons.

LM has applied to temporarily close a section of Red Lane for a few hours during the day on **Friday 12 February** to finalise a crossing for the Kenilworth Greenway diversion. We had planned to do this work under temporary traffic lights, but after discussing with local authorities, we’ve proposed a closure to carry out more work, speed up our construction programme and reduce overall impacts on Red Lane.

It will also enable us to finish pieces of LM work before Balfour Beatty VINCI (BBV) works on Cromwell Lane in the week commencing 15 February. For more information on BBV’s work, contact the HS2 Helpdesk quoting HS2-MW-BBV-Ph1-Ar-No-N1-Traf-50-22/01/2021.
