Updated notice of traffic management in Stoneleigh

High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. Early works for HS2 are now underway in your area, carried out by LM – a joint venture between Laing O’Rourke and J. Murphy & Sons.

The work outlined in this notice may be subject to changes and consents. Maps are included on the following pages.

Night closures switching to daytime

LM previously notified that will be surveying roads in Stoneleigh at night. This work will now take place during the day. For the safety of everyone in the area, we will need to temporarily close and divert small sections of roads **between 9.30am and 3.30pm each working day**.

Birmingham Road	Stoneleigh Road/B4115 to Stoneleigh Close	Monday 20 July to Thursday 23 July
Birmingham Road	Hall Close to B4113 Coventry Road	Friday 24 July, Monday 27 July and Tuesday 28 July
Coventry Road	Stoneleigh Bridge	Wednesday 29 July and Thursday 30 July

Additional work near village hall, Birmingham Road

LM will also be at work on Birmingham Road in Stoneleigh for a few weeks from the **week commencing Monday 20 July**. This will involve daytime work within the verges, supported by temporary three-way traffic lights which will be lifted from the road when we’re not at work.

A team of around 4 people, a lorry and an excavator will be testing and taking samples from the water main to inform future works.

For three-way traffic lights on Birmingham Road – between 8.00am and 4.30pm.

We might be on site for up to one hour before or after these times, to set up or pack up.

What we will do

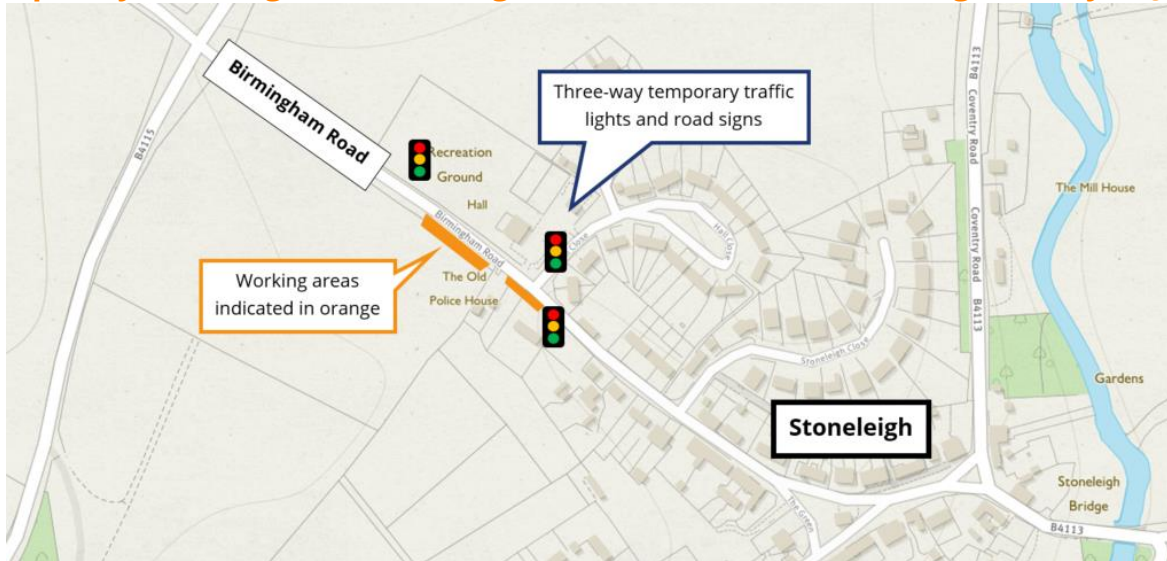
Keep disruptions to a minimum and maintain access to properties.

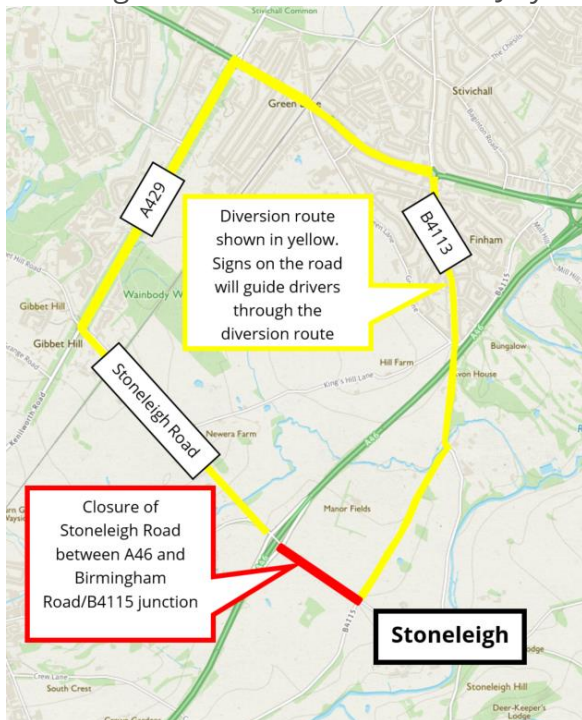
Maps for traffic management locations

Birmingham Road closure from 20-23 July

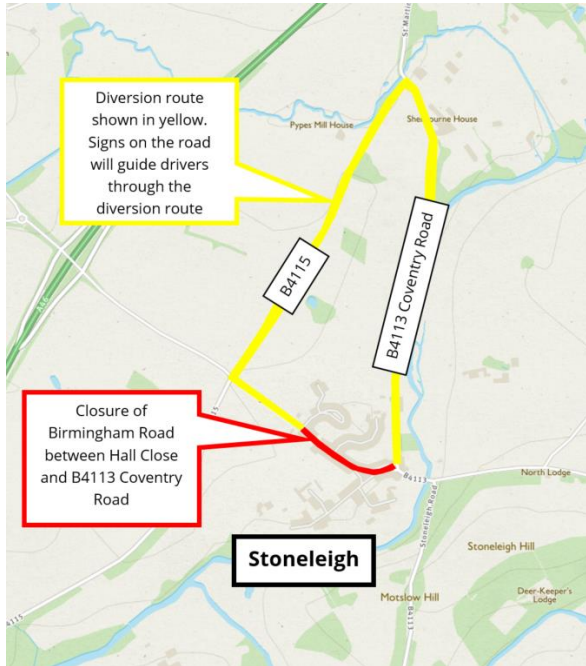

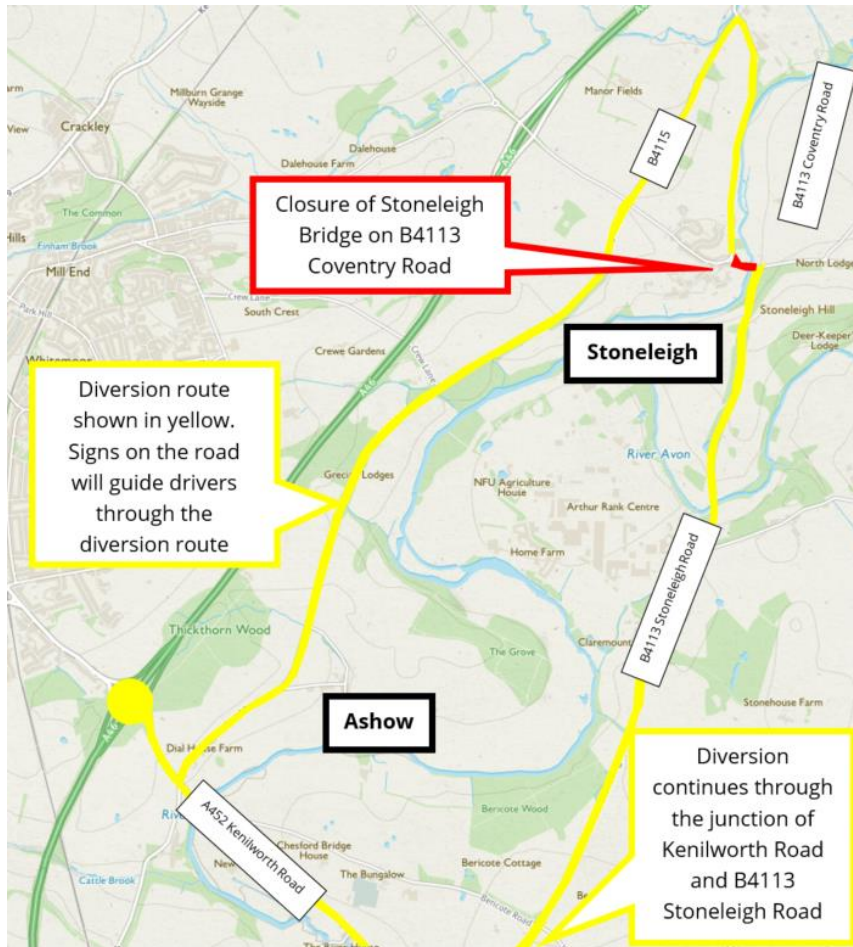
Birmingham Road closure on 24, 27 and 28 July
