Notice of temporary closure of Attleboro Lane

Notification



High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. Early works for HS2 are carried out by LM – a joint venture between Laing O'Rourke and J. Murphy & Sons.

Works planned near Water Orton

Over the coming months, we'll be working near Water Orton to prepare the route for the new railway ahead of main works construction. This work includes vegetation clearance and some tree clearance, alongside our ongoing archaeological investigations.

Where the road closure will be

We will be temporarily closing Attleboro Lane during the day to create a safe zone for accessing our work sites.

The closure will be in place between **9:30 and 15:30** on week days from 27th January for around three weeks (subject to site and weather conditions). Please see the map overleaf.

Marshalls will escort pedestrians safely through the works. Access to properties will be maintained during these works.

Why we're doing this work

We need to prepare as much of the route as possible over the coming months. This will ensure that our main construction work can commence on time. It is also important to complete this work during this time of year as it is outside of key periods in the ecological calendar and helps to minimise our impact on local wildlife.

Road closure will be in operation from the week commencing 27th January for around three weeks.

The closure will be in effect between 9:30-15:30 on week days. We might be on site for up to one hour before or after the works take place.
