High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. We are writing to make you aware of the next stage of work that will be undertaken by Western Power Distribution that is related to HS2.

What are we doing?

Western Power Distribution are drilling three boreholes in land adjacent to Attleboro Lane. These works will take a maximum of three days to complete. Contractors will park at no.87 Attleboro Lane, and ensure the highway is not obstructed. There will be two vehicles and five workers on site. Both vehicles will be cleaned at the end of each shift, before leaving site.

Covid 19

WPD are delivering these works on behalf of HS2 Ltd. HS2 is continually reviewing the works on its construction sites in line with Government and Public Health England (PHE) advice on dealing with COVID-19. The Government's current COVID-19 strategy makes clear that construction activity can continue as long as it complies with this guidance.

The health and safety of our workforce and the communities we affect is our key priority. Please be assured that those sites that are currently still working are doing so because they can operate within PHE and construction industry guidelines.

How will this affect me?

The works will mainly be in a construction area that will have no impact on the local community. The normal working hours for this will be **Wednesday to Friday 8am to 4pm**.

Our contractors may also be on site for **surveys and security checks outside of these hours**.
