

## Notice of pipeline diversion works in Chattlehill

High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. Cadent is moving underground gas pipelines in the Coleshill area, to allow for the construction of the new railway and to continue to ensure a safe and reliable gas supply.

We will be starting work to move one of the pipelines in March 2020 and expect all our work in the Coleshill area to be completed by October 2020.

### What are we doing?

We will continue to use our main works compound off Watton Lane as our main site. We will also be working from our existing sites north of Watton Lane and east of Lichfield Road.

The work will involve:

- Setting up a new temporary working area north of the Birmingham-Peterborough railway line.
- Digging trenches for the new pipeline route in the area and boring two tunnels
- Welding the pipe together then installing it in the trench

There will be 24-hour security on site so we can maintain a safe working environment. Please note, there will be no on-site lodging.

### How will this affect you?

Our tunnelling work will involve using a boring machine that may need to run 24 hours. However, this work is underground so we do not anticipate any additional noise or disruption for local people.

We will occasionally need to temporarily close the footpath off Lichfield Road, next to Bovis Homes. We will put signs up to make people aware of this and a diversion will be in place.

There will not be any disruption to your utilities during our works.

### Duration of work

- March 2020 to October 2020
- Our core working hours will be 8.00am to 6.00pm (Mon-Fri) and 8.00am to 1.00pm (Sat) excluding tunnelling works
- We will be on-site one hour either side of these times for set-up and close-down

### What to expect

- No additional disruption or noise from underground tunnelling work
- Vehicles will access existing works areas via Watton Lane and Gorsey Lane
- Vehicles will access the extended working area via Hams Hall industrial estate and A446 (Lichfield Road)

### What we will do

- Inform you as our work progresses
- Make sure there is minimal disruption to local people
- Maintain a safe working environment
