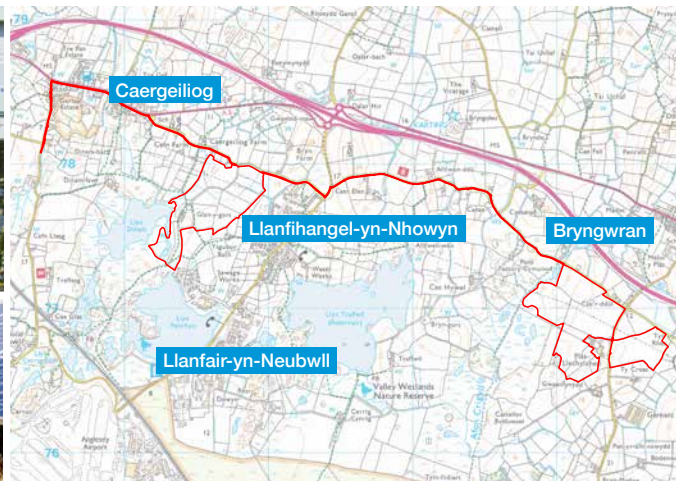




We are exploring the potential to develop a solar farm with an export capacity of circa 35MW on the west side of the island of Anglesey, called Parc Solar Traffwll.

The development would produce enough clean energy to power approximately 11,600 homes per year and offset over 7,840 tonnes of CO<sub>2</sub> every year, the equivalent of taking around 3,620 cars off the road.<sup>1</sup>



## Project Overview

The proposed project site is split into a number of development areas around Llanfihangel-yn-Nhywyn, and south/south west of Bryngwran. RAF Valley lies a little further to the south west of the site. The A55, the main arterial route running east to west through the island to Holyhead, lies to the north of the site.

This project is deemed a Development of National Significance (DNS), meaning that we will need to apply to the Planning Inspectorate Wales, which will make a recommendation to Welsh Ministers who will make the final decision.

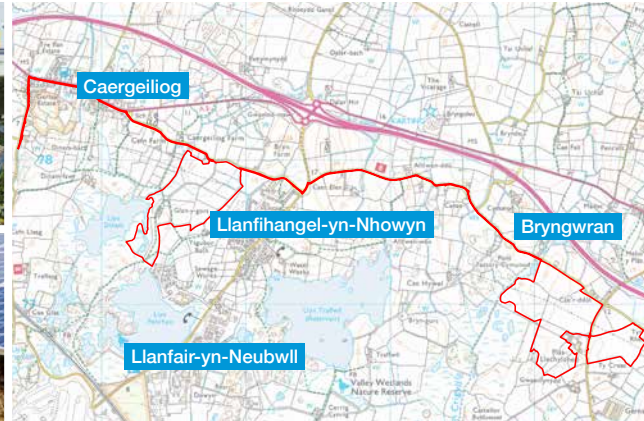
