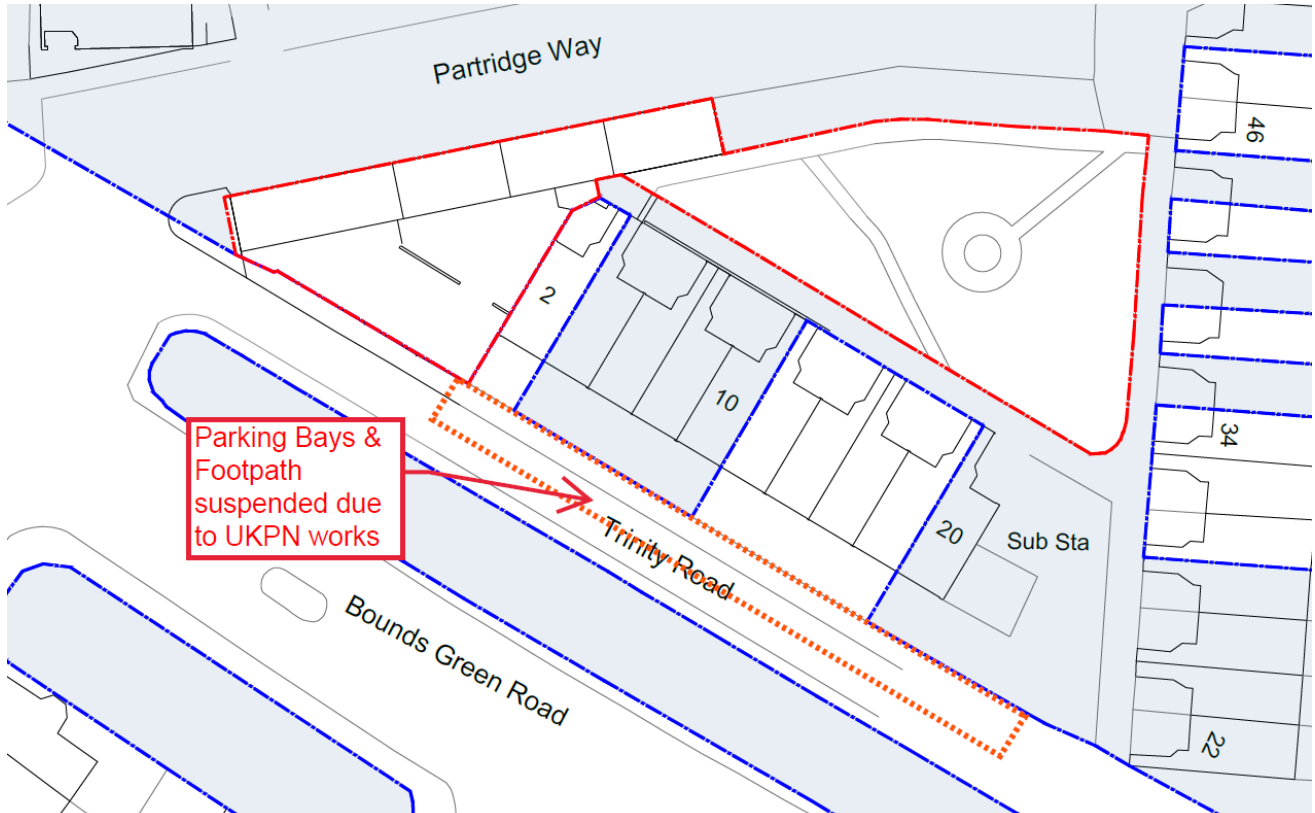
New Council homes at a site close to Partridge Way – Parking Bay Suspensions

As you are aware, Haringey Council has received planning permission to build twenty-three new council homes at a site close to Partridge Way. This is part of the Council’s ambitious home building programme that aims to deliver 3,000 new council homes across the borough in the next decade.

Formation Design and Build (Ltd) have been appointed to deliver the new homes for the Council.

In terms of the next stage of works, the UK Power Network (UKPN) which manages the electricity supply to the area, are planning to lay the duct to site from the existing substation. The location of the dig will be along Trinity Road in the footpath. Please note that the electricity supply to your home will not be affected. However, this work will require digging and other construction activity on Trinity Road.

As part of this, UKPN will need to suspend a number of parking bays and the footpath from Monday 5 February 2024 until Friday 9 February 2024. Please see the below diagram which shows the parking bays that will be suspended.
