

**SOUTH TYNESIDE COUNCIL
MOUNTBATTEN AVE, HEBBURN
TRAFFIC CALMING PROPOSALS 2022**

South Tyneside Council proposes under Sections 90A and 90C of the Highways Act 1980 and the Highways (Road Humps) Regulations 1999 to undertake the following:
Install traffic calming (all being road humps within the meaning of the Highways Act 1980) consisting of full width road humps along Mountbatten Ave, Hebburn.

The proposed humps will consist of a raised surface 75mm above the existing carriageway. The proposed locations are as follows in the below schedules:

Schedule 1 – Road Hump (Kerb to kerb in width and 3.7m in length)

Mountbatten Ave	Outside 6 Mountbatten Ave
Mountbatten Ave	Outside 32 Mountbatten Ave
Mountbatten Ave	From a point 120m west of its junction with Acacia Gr
Mountbatten Ave	From a point 32m west of its junction with Acacia Gr
Mountbatten Ave	Outside 41 & 43 Mountbatten Ave
Mountbatten Ave	From a point 170m west of its junction with Finchale Rd
Mountbatten Ave	From a point 90m west of its junction with Finchale Rd

The traffic calming is necessary to reduce traffic speeds.
