The Vicarage

Dear Friends,

As some of you will know, on **Sunday 21st October** Rod Thomas, the Bishop of Maidstone will be joining us at our 6.30pm service. For many, this will be our first opportunity to meet Rod, and to hear from him as he preaches to us. At the same time, Rod will be confirming a number of people from St Alkmund's and St Paul's who want to publicly declare their faith in Jesus and their membership of our churches. I know that the end of October is a long way off, but I mention this now as there are at least three things we can do to prepare.

First, do pray for Rod in his ministry, and the candidates as they prepare for confirmation. Rod Thomas has a ministry to those churches who cannot in conscience accept the ministry of female Bishops, and that takes him all around the country and to over 100 churches. As this is a developing area, there are lots of conversations, some of them hard, with various Bishops and dioceses. For our confirmation candidates, pray that this will be an opportunity for them to articulate their faith, and a significant step on their walk with Christ.

Second, come and join us on the 21st October even if it is not your usual practice to come twice. You never know – you might like it! we won't be able to have Rod Thomas come to us very often, so do take this opportunity. It will also be a great encouragement to those being confirmed, and to their families.

It is a closed event (youth leaders will be bringing their youth groups and supervise them), but we'll be expecting up to 100 young people!


Helen is looking for DBS'd volunteers to:
