Interregnum Update: 14th June 2019

This is the first of a series of regular updates intended to keep you up to date with what is happening during the interregnum process.

Latest developments:

- Although Steve and Rachel left us a few weeks ago, Steve's tenure formally ends today, 14th June 2019, which means we now formally enter the interregnum process!
- In the meantime, PCC and the Wardens and Deputy Wardens have been preparing for the formal interregnum process by working on a draft Parish Profile, and thinking and praying through the appointments process and how this might operate.

What happens next?

- On Tuesday 19th June 2019 the PCC will meet with the Archdeacon of Manchester and the General Director of CPAS (our "Patron") for an informal "pre-vacancy meeting" in order to ask questions about the appointments process.
- On 9th July 2019 the PCC will hold a 'section 11' meeting at which the PCC must formally decide on a number of points, including who to appoint as parish representatives for the appointments process, and what the final version of the Parish Profile should look like.
