

- 1 June** "May the God who gives endurance and encouragement give you the same attitude of mind toward each other that Christ Jesus had, so that with one mind and one voice you may glorify the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ." Rom 15v5-6
- 2 June** Give thanks that Anna Sims, our mission partner in Peru, is with our church family today. Pray that both Anna and us would keep on running the race with perseverance, fixing our eyes on Jesus.
- 3 June** Pray for wisdom as the Prospects team meet tonight. Ask that they would be well-equipped to serve Prospects members.
- 4 June** Give thanks that even during times of change at Platt, we can come boldly to our heavenly Father and cast all our anxiety on him knowing that he cares for us. Pray we would do so at the CPG tonight.
- 5 June** Pray for the Spirit to be at work as Heald Place Primary school comes to visit today. Ask that the gospel would be presented clearly.
- 6 June** As SBS finishes the book of Jonah, pray that the students would have a deeper view of God's mercy.
- 7 June** Pray for our partner churches at St Martin's and St Mary's. Ask that their love for Jesus and one another may abound more and more as they grow in their knowledge of God's words.
- 8 June** The Inspire women's breakfast is happening today. Ask that it would be a fruitful time of getting to know one another better and building one another up in God's words.
- 9 June** Ask that in the midst of changes at Platt, we would be rooted in Jesus. Pray they we would be united and be protected from the devil's attacks.
- 10 June** Pray for Ruth and the MTs as they lead reading weeks with some of our students. Pray that they would have a refreshing time being challenged and changed by God's words.
- 11 June** Pray that as the Word One to One groups starts at Roots, the Spirit would be at work and open the eyes of those enquiring so that they may understand the gospel and come to faith.
- 12 June** Pray that as house groups continue looking at God's promises to Abraham, they would be overflowing with thankfulness knowing that those who have faith in Jesus are children of Abraham. (Gal. 3)
- 13 June** Pray that as WBS meet each week to look at God's words, they would enjoy meditating and storing up God's words in their hearts.
- 14 June** Give thanks for all those in our neighborhood who were at the Spring Fair last month. Ask for God to be at work in their hearts.

- 15 June** Pray that in this testing time, the Wheatleys would have great endurance and patience as they trust in God's sovereignty.
- 16 June** Pray for Splatt, our toddlers group that takes place every Tuesday. Give thanks for carers/parents that come and pray that God would be at work in their hearts.
- 17 June** Pray for our church family as we start a new week, that whatever we do, whether in word or deed, do it all in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God the Father through him. (Col 3v17)
- 18 June** Ask the Lord to give members of the PCC wisdom as they make decisions tonight. Pray that they would seek first God's kingdom as they do so.
- 19 June** Pray that as our youth and children come each week, they would be gripped by the gospel and be willing to offer up their lives as a living sacrifice, holy and pleasing to God. (Rom 12v1)
- 20 June** Pray for Tim Forester as he travels to Ethiopia this month to help equip a new generation with the vision and tools for disciple making. Ask that God would grant the young people long-term faithfulness in ministry.
- 21 June** Ask that God would sustain Pete Horlock as he continues to lead Ministry2Business. Ask that he and the Christian workers would have the same compassion for the lost as Jesus.
- 22 June** Join the Robinsons in praying for Cambodia. Ask especially that more Christians would be active in helping the poor and needy in the area.
- 23 June** Give thanks for those getting baptised today. Pray that they would be welcomed into the church family and would be refined to be more like Jesus.
- 24 June** Give thanks for Steve and Rachel and pray that even in this new phase of life they would not lack in their zeal for the gospel and their desire to see many won for Christ.
- 25 June** Pray for our seniors at Oasis, that they would overflow in their love for one another and especially to those who have not come in a while and are unwell.
- 26 June** Give thanks for the connections Platt has with the local schools. Pray these relationships would continue and that many of the students and teacher would be able to hear the gospel.
- 27 June** Give thanks that our God is at work in our city. Ask that he would continue to open up new doors and opportunities for the gospel to be proclaimed in Manchester.
- 28 June** The summer Sound conference is taking place today. Ask that the young people attending would have a fruitful time listening to God's words and encouraging one another.
- 29 June** Pray that God will continue to use the REAP course to raise up workers for his harvest field.
- 30 June** Pray for Manchester International Outreach as they have their orientation day today. Ask that the team would be excited to share the gospel with those they meet during the next two weeks.
