STATEMENT FROM THE JUDICIAL CONDUCT INVESTIGATIONS OFFICE

Deputy District Judge Simon Kenny

A spokesperson for the Judicial Conduct Investigations Office said:

“Deputy District Judge Simon Kenny has been removed from judicial office following an investigation into his conduct as a solicitor, which led to him being struck from the roll of solicitors. Deputy District Judge Kenny also failed to keep the Lord Chief Justice informed of these proceedings. The Lord Chancellor and the Lord Chief Justice concluded that his actions were incompatible with his position as a Deputy District Judge and have removed him from office.”
