A spokesperson for the Judicial Conduct Investigations Office said:

“Mr David Hall, a Recorder serving the Midland Circuit, was declared bankrupt on 2<sup>nd</sup> December 2013. The Lord Chancellor and the Lord Chief Justice found that in the circumstances of this case his financial situation was incompatible with holding judicial office and have removed Mr Hall from office.”
