A spokesperson for the Judicial Conduct Investigations Office said:

“Miss Constance Briscoe, a Recorder and Fee-Paid Tribunal Judge of the First-tier Health, Education and Social Care Chamber has been removed from judicial office without further investigation by the Lord Chancellor and the Lord Chief Justice following her conviction and sentence for perverting the course of justice. Miss Briscoe has not undertaken any judicial duties since her arrest on 6 October 2012.”
