### Deputy District Judge Douglas Harrison

A spokesperson for the Judicial Conduct Investigations Office said:

“Following an investigation by the Judicial Conduct Investigations Office into an allegation made by a member of court staff that Deputy District Judge Douglas Harrison had inappropriately touched her waist and arm, the Lord Chancellor and the Lord Chief Justice have concluded that this behaviour amounted to serious misconduct and have removed Deputy District Judge Harrison from judicial office”.
