STATEMENT FROM THE JUDICIAL CONDUCT INVESTIGATIONS OFFICE

A spokesperson for the Judicial Conduct Investigations Office said:

“Mr Nathan Ayisi-Biney, a magistrate appointed to the Bolton Bench, has been removed from judicial office following a conduct investigation into a complaint about his behaviour in the Retiring Room at Bolton Magistrates Court on 1 April 2014. The Lord Chancellor and Lord Chief Justice considered that Mr Ayisi-Biney’s conduct was inappropriate, his language abusive and his actions threatening and that these amounted to serious misconduct warranting removal from the magistracy”.
