## STATEMENT FROM THE JUDICIAL CONDUCT INVESTIGATIONS OFFICE

### Mr Paul Millross JP

A spokesperson for the Judicial Conduct Investigations Office said:

*“Mr Paul Millross, a magistrate appointed to the Sussex area, was subject to a conduct investigation for failing to engage with his Justices Clerk, for making inaccurate representations about his council tax arrears, for giving a media interview in breach of guidance from his advisory committee and for breaching confidentiality. The Lord Chancellor and the Lord Chief Justice found that Mr Millross’s actions were incompatible with his remaining a judicial office holder and have removed him from the Magistracy.”*
