STATEMENT FROM THE JUDICIAL CONDUCT INVESTIGATIONS OFFICE

Mr Daniel Ibekwe

A spokesperson for the Judicial Conduct Investigations Office said:

“Mr Daniel Ibekwe, a non-legal member for the Employment Tribunal, London South region, has been removed following an investigation into his conduct. It was found that by appearing as a representative before the London South Tribunals in the same region where he sat as a panel member, and for failing to engage with his Regional Employment Judge and President of the Employment Tribunals, Mr Ibekwe had not upheld his judicial obligations. The Lord Chancellor and the Lord Chief Justice considered that Mr Ibekwe had failed to demonstrate the standard expected of a judicial office holder and have therefore removed him from office.”
